THE FORESTRY ORDINANCE
(CAP. 86)

The Forestry (Buya-Rosoni Native Administration
Protected Forest No.1) Order in Council, 1950.

In exercise of the Powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by Section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Paramount Chief and the Tribal Authority of the Buya-Rosoni Chiefdom in the Port Loko District of the Northern Province of the Protectorate of Sierra Leone.

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Buya-Rosoni Native Administration Protected Forest No.1) Order in Council, 1950.
2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

SCHEDULE.

ALL THAT PIECE OF LAND, comprising 70 acres or thereabouts, situated in the Buya-Rosoni Chiefdom in the Port Loko District of the Northern Province of the Protectorate of Sierra Leone and bounded as follows:-

- SOUTH** Starting from Boundary Mark No.1, which is a stone cairn situated on the western side of the motor road from Rosint to Gointi at the point where the said road crosses the Rosian stream; thence by the right bank of the stream down-stream for a distance of about 11°60 chains to Boundary Mark No.2; thence by a demarcated line cut on a bearing of approximately 246°37' for a distance of about 0°58 chains to Boundary Mark No.3, which is on the eastern side of the hammock trail leading on to Port Loko; thence by the eastern side of the said hammock trail for a distance of about 10°55 chains in a north-easterly direction to Boundary Mark No.4; thence by the northern side of the said hammock trail for a distance of about 36°50 chains in a north-westerly direction to Boundary Mark No.5; thence
- WEST** by a demarcated line cut on a bearing of approximately 359°31' for a distance of about 17°25 chains to Boundary Mark No.6; thence
- NORTH** by a demarcated line cut on a bearing of approximately 77°15' for a distance of about 13°30 chains to Boundary Mark No.7, which is situated on the western side of the motor road from Rosint to Gointi; thence
- EAST** by the western side of the said motor road in a south-easterly direction for a distance of about 50°40 chains to Boundary Mark No.1, which is the starting point.

As the same is more particularly delineated on plan No. 61/49 in the office of the Divisional Forest Officer, Betkenu, and is shown thereon verged RED.

NOTE:

- (i) All Bearings given above are magnetic bearings taken in the year 1949
- (ii) All Distances given above are in Gunter's chains of 66 feet.
- (iii) All Boundary Marks mentioned above are stone cairns.
- (iv) Demarcated lines mentioned above are cleared traces marked at salient points by stone cairns.
