1. This Order may be cited as the Dama Protected Forest Order.

2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a protected forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

SCHEDULE.

All that area of land in the Dama Chiefdom in the Kenema District bounded within the following boundaries—

Starting from boundary stone No. 1, which is on the left edge of the Kenema-Giema motor road at 7.70 miles along the said motor road; thence on a magnetic bearing of $62^{\circ} 00'$ for a distance of 520.0 feet more or less to boundary stone No. 2; thence on a magnetic bearing of $142^{\circ} 00'$ for a distance of 460.00 feet more or less to boundary stone No. 3; thence on a magnetic bearing of $56^{\circ} 30'$ for a distance of 1,620.00 feet more or less to boundary stone No. 4; thence on a magnetic bearing of $138^{\circ} 30'$ for a distance of 187.78 feet more or less to boundary stone No. 5; thence on a magnetic bearing of $142^{\circ} 00'$ for a distance of 198.00 feet more or less to boundary stone No. 6; thence on a magnetic bearing of $138^{\circ} 30'$ for a distance of 725.00 feet more or less to boundary stone No. 7; thence along the Teyema-Giema footpath in a general south-south westerly direction for a distance of 1,836.63 feet more or less to boundary stone No. 8; thence on a magnetic bearing of $263^{\circ} 30'$ for a distance of 515.00 feet more or less to boundary stone No. 9; thence on a magnetic bearing of $260^{\circ} 30'$ for a distance of 360.00 feet more or less to boundary stone No. 10; thence on a magnetic bearing of $323^{\circ} 30'$ for a distance of 127.00 feet more or less to boundary stone No. 11; thence on a magnetic bearing of $317^{\circ} 00'$ for a distance of 155.10 feet more or less to boundary stone No. 12; thence on a magnetic bearing of $318^{\circ} 00'$ for a distance of 340.56 feet more or less to boundary stone No. 13; thence on a magnetic bearing of $316^{\circ} 00'$ for a distance of 269.94 feet more or less to boundary stone No. 14; thence on a magnetic bearing of $312^{\circ} 00'$ for a distance of 300.00 feet more or less to boundary stone No. 15; thence on a magnetic bearing of $227^{\circ} 00'$ for a distance of 567.60 feet more or less to boundary stone No. 16; thence on a magnetic bearing of $227^{\circ} 00'$ for a distance of 567.60 feet more or less to boundary stone No. 17; thence along the left edge of the Kenema-Giema motor road in a general north-westerly direction for a distance of 1,031.00 feet more or less to boundary stone No. 1, which is the starting point.
