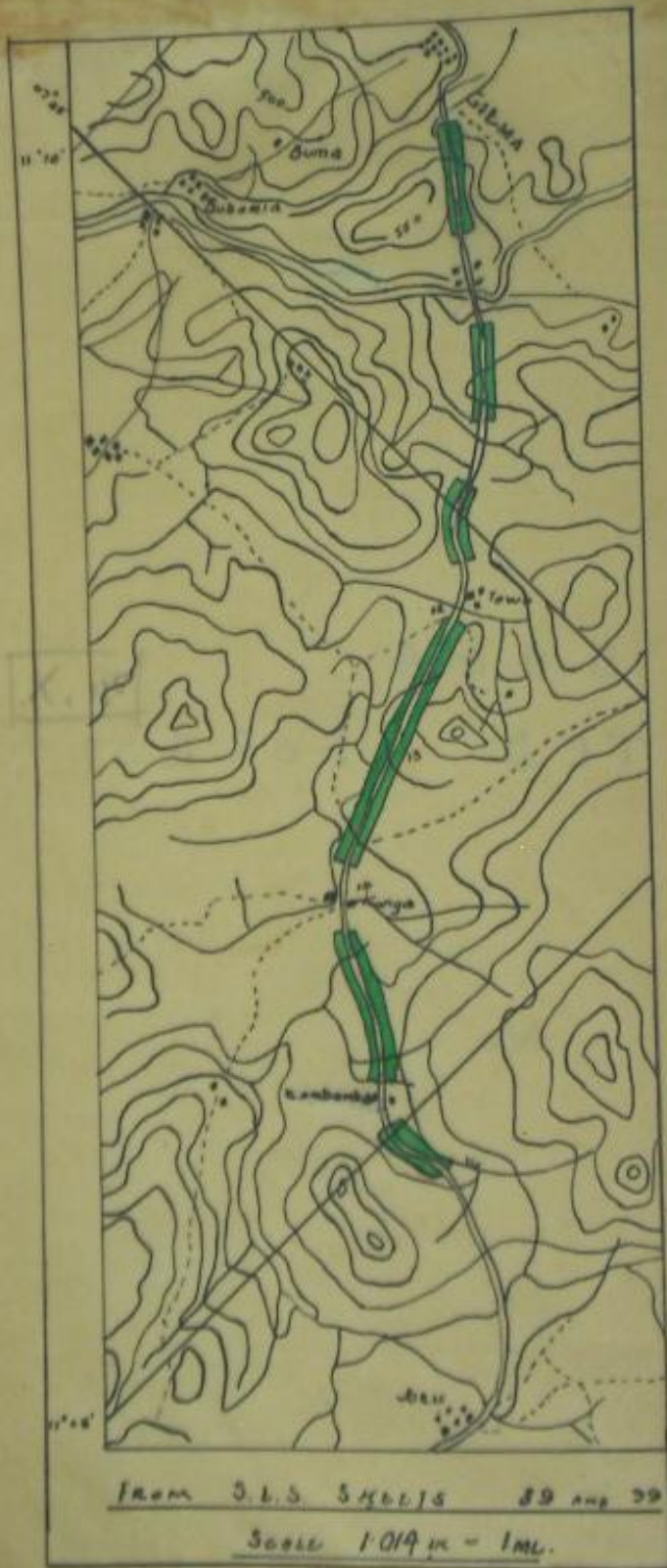

*THE FORESTRY ORDINANCE*  
(Cap. 86)

THE FORESTRY (DAMA NATIVE ADMINISTRATION PROTECTED  
FOREST No. 5) ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1952

In exercise of the Powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance (Cap. 86 of the laws of Sierra Leone) the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Paramount Chief and members of the Tribal Authority of the Dama Chiefdom in the Kenema District of the South-eastern Province.

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Dama Native Administration Protected Forest No. 5) Order in Council, 1952.
2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT LAND, comprising 382 acres or thereabouts, in the Dama Chiefdom in the Kenema District of the South-eastern Province of the Protectorate of Sierra Leone, bounded by a cleared trace and lying within 330 feet on either side of the centre of the main 1950 motor road from Kenema in the South-eastern Province and Zimi in the South-western Province, starting at Mile Post 9 and ending at a point which is about 560 feet from Mile Post 16, measured towards Mile Post 15, provided that the following areas shall be excluded from the Protected Forest:—

Between points distant about 1,635 feet and 1,644 feet from Mile Post 10, measured towards Mile Post 9 and Mile Post 11, respectively, including Foya Village, which lies on both sides of the motor road.

Between points distant about 240 feet and 1,634 feet from Mile Post 11, measured towards Mile Post 10 and Mile Post 12, respectively which lies on both sides of the motor road.

Between points distant about 1,868 feet and 330 feet from Mile Post 12, measured towards Mile Post 11 and Mile Post 13, respectively, including Tewa Village, which lies on both sides of the motor road.

Between points distant about 945 feet and 1,167 feet from Mile Post 14, measured towards Mile Post 13 and Mile Post 15, respectively, including Kanga Village which lies on both sides of the motor road.
