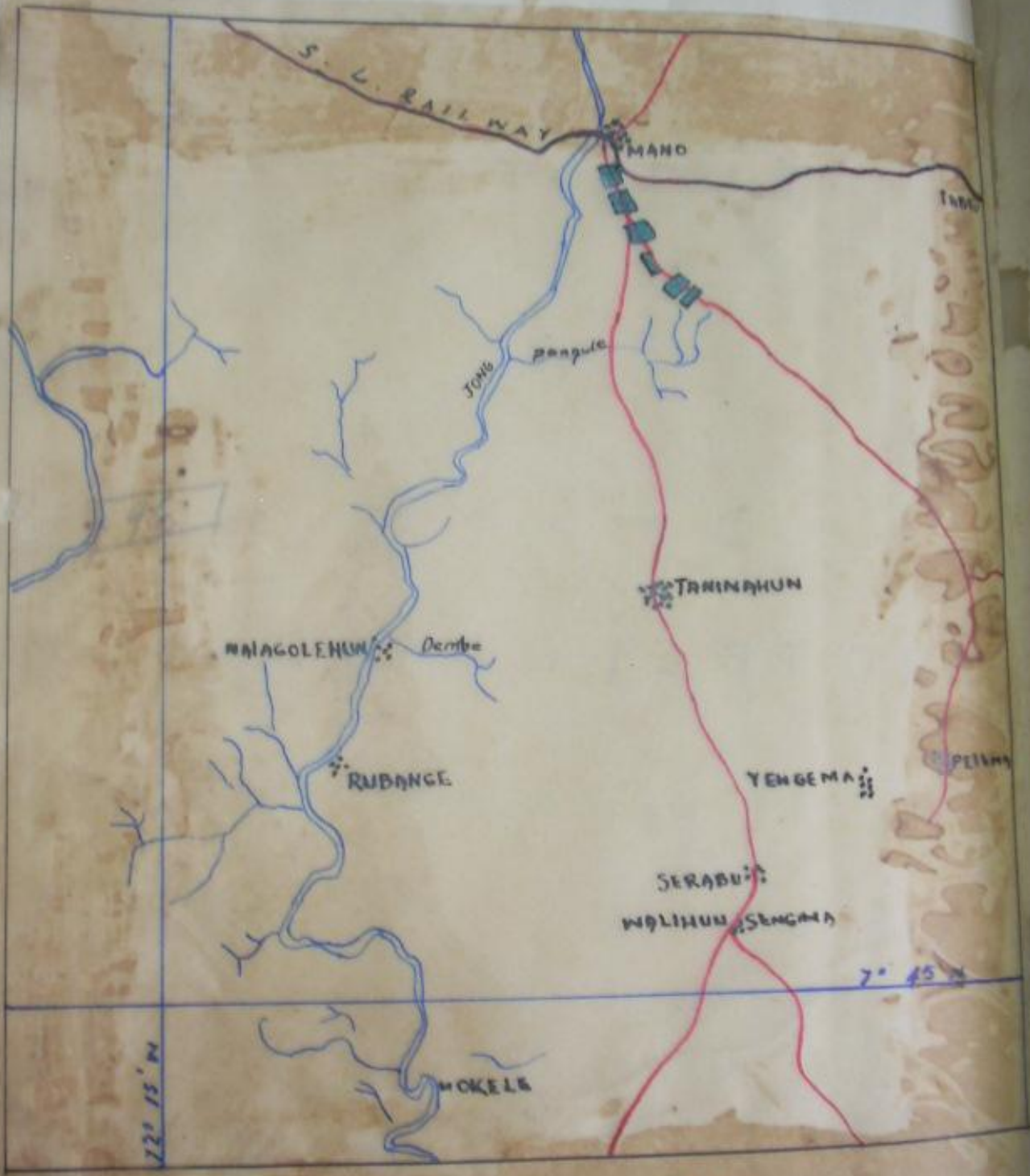

THE FORESTRY ORDINANCE
(Cap. 86)

**THE FORESTRY (DASE NO. 1 NATIVE ADMINISTRATION (ROADSIDE)
PROTECTED FOREST) ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1950.**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Paramount Chief and members of the Tribal Authority of the Dase Chiefdom, Moyamba District:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Dase No. 1 Native Administration (Roadside) Protected Forest) Order in Council, 1950.
2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

Cap. 86.

ALL THAT PIECE OF LAND comprising 84.7 acres or thereabouts, bounded by a cleared trace and lying within 210 feet on either side of the centre of the road from Mano to Bumpe in the Dase Chiefdom in the Moyamba District of the South-western Province of the Protectorate of Sierra Leone, starting at a point 3,960 feet in a southerly direction from the railway crossing at Mano and ceasing at the Bumpe Chiefdom boundary on the River Pongule, 19,590 feet from the starting point, provided that the following areas shall be excluded from the Protected Forest now requested:—

Between points 2,251 feet and 3,040 feet distant from the starting point which includes a swamp.

Between points 5,937 feet and 8,890 feet distant from the starting point which includes the Villages of Salna and Mogboama (spelt "Mogwama" on Sheet No. 74 of the Sierra Leone Topographical Survey) and swamps.

Between points 14,040 feet and 14,197 feet distant from the starting point which includes a swamp.

Between points 14,197 feet and 16,240 feet distant from the starting point on the east side of the road only which includes a swamp.

Between points 16,240 feet and 16,757 feet distant from the starting point which includes a swamp.

Between points 17,698 feet and 19,295 feet distant from the starting point which includes the village of Gerahun (spelt "Jayahun" on Sheet No. 85 of the Sierra Leone Topographical Survey).

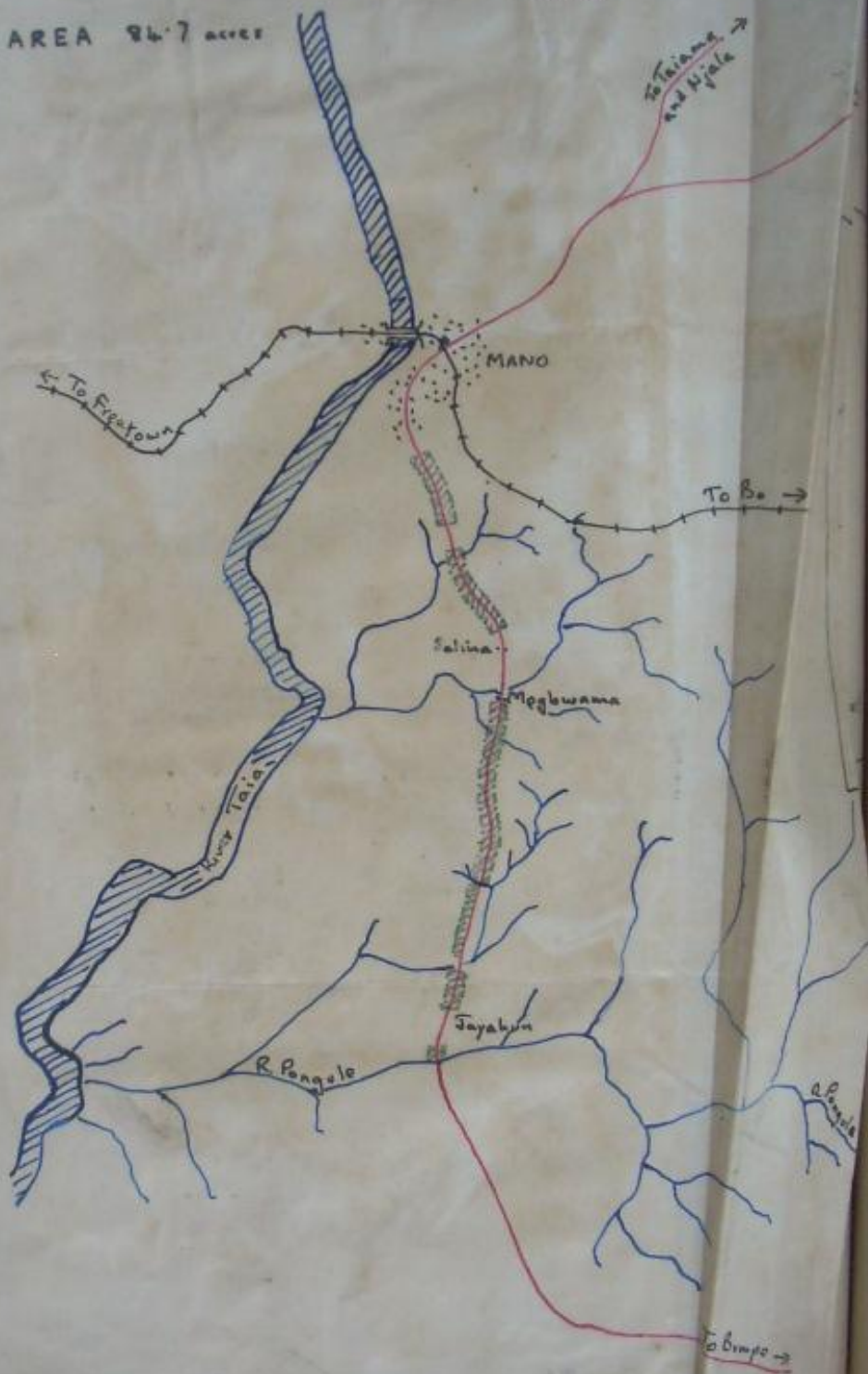
