(Cap. 86)

**THE FORESTRY (FAKUNYA PROTECTED FOREST No. 1) ORDER
IN COUNCIL, 1952**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Tribal Authority of the Fakunya Chiefdom, Moyamba District, South-western Province:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Fakunya Protected Forest No. 1) Order in Council, 1952.

Area - 427 acres

2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest.

SCHEDULE

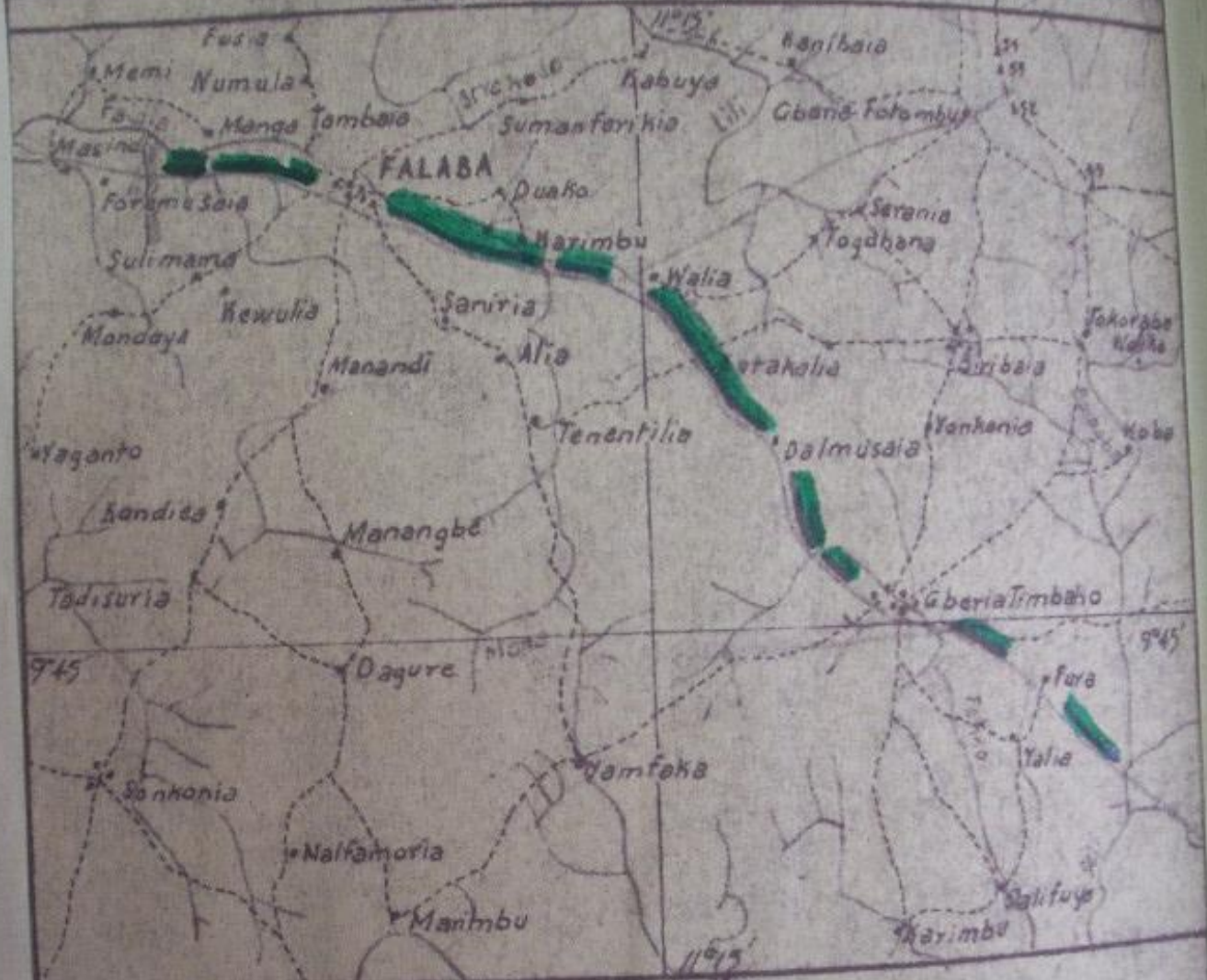
ALL THAT LAND comprising 427 acres or thereabouts lying within 220 feet on either side of the centre of the motor road from Moyamba to the Bo-Freetown road, and bounded by a cleared trace; commencing at the boundary between Fakunya and Kaiyamba Chiefdoms, which is marked by stone cairns, and ending at the boundary between Fakunya and Yoni Chiefdoms, which is the Batkump River.

Provided that the following areas measured in a northerly direction from the starting point shall be excluded from the Protected Forest:—

Between points distant about 4,000 feet and 9,600 feet from the starting point which includes Fataba Village and the Mogbindie, Tama and Nanaye Streams.

Between points distant about 18,195 feet and 37,200 feet from the starting point which includes Gandohun and Gbangbama Villages and Kpeluwa, Gbangbaia and Bebye Rivers and swamp.

THE FORESTRY ORDINANCE
(Cap. 86)

THE FORESTRY (FALABA ROADSIDE PROTECTED FOREST)
ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1956

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Paramount Chief and Tribal Authority of the Dembelia Sinkunia and of the Sulima Chiefdoms, Koinadugu District, Northern Province:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Falaba Roadside Protected Forest) Order in Council, 1956.
2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

All that land comprising 1,511.00 acres or thereabouts lying within 710 feet on the left hand side of the centre of the motor road from Sinkunia to Kombile in the chiefdoms of Dembelia Sinkunia and Sulima.

Commencing at about 12.00 chains measured along the centre of the road in the direction of Kombile from milestone 104 and ending at a stone cairn about 8.24 chains from the centre of the bridge over the Seli river measured along the centre of the road in the direction of Kabile, provided that the following areas shall be excluded from the Protected Forest—

These areas lying on the left hand side and within 710 feet of the centre of the motor road as defined in the following table:—

- (i) All distances given in the table above are measured in Gunter's chain of 66 feet along the centre of the motor road in the direction Falaba—Kabile and are approximate.
- (ii) All that land not being excluded above lying within 50 feet of the centre of the motor road and on the left hand thereof.
