THE FORESTRY (GALLINAS PROTECTED FOREST NO. 1) ORDER IN  
COUNCIL, 1952

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Paramount Chief and Tribal Authority of the Gallinas Chiefdom, Pujehun District, South-western Province.

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Gallinas Protected Forest No. 1) Order in Council, 1952.

2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT PIECE OR PARCEL OF LAND, comprising 186 acres or thereabouts, situated in the Gallinas Chiefdom in the Pujehun District of the South-western Province of the Protectorate of Sierra Leone and bounded as follows:—

NORTH—

Starting from Boundary Mark No. 1 which is situated on the South side of the footpath from Blama to Juring about 290 feet East of where the footpath crosses the Emayei River; thence by the said footpath in an easterly direction for a distance of about 1,091 feet to Boundary Mark No. 2 which is situated on the South side of the path; thence by a demarcated line
