**THE FORESTRY (GAURA PROTECTED FOREST NO. 1)
ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1953**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Tribal Authority of the Gaura Chiefdom, Kenema District, South-eastern Province:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Gaura Protected Forest No. 1) Order in Council, 1953.
2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT LAND, comprising 58.2 acres or thereabouts, in the Gaura Chiefdom in the Kenema District of the South-eastern Province of the Protectorate of Sierra Leone, bounded by a cleared trace and lying within 5 chains on either side of the centre of the Giema-Zimmi Motor Road, starting from a point distant about 30.8 chains from milestone 17 measured towards milestone 16 and ending at the boundary between Gaura and Daga Chiefdoms which is distant about 9 chains from milestone 16 measured towards milestone 15.

As the same is more particularly delineated on plan No. K. 162 of the Forestry Department, and shown thereon verged GREEN.

- Note.*—1. All measurements are in chains of 66 ft.
2. All distances given in relation to milestone are measured along the centre of the motor road.
