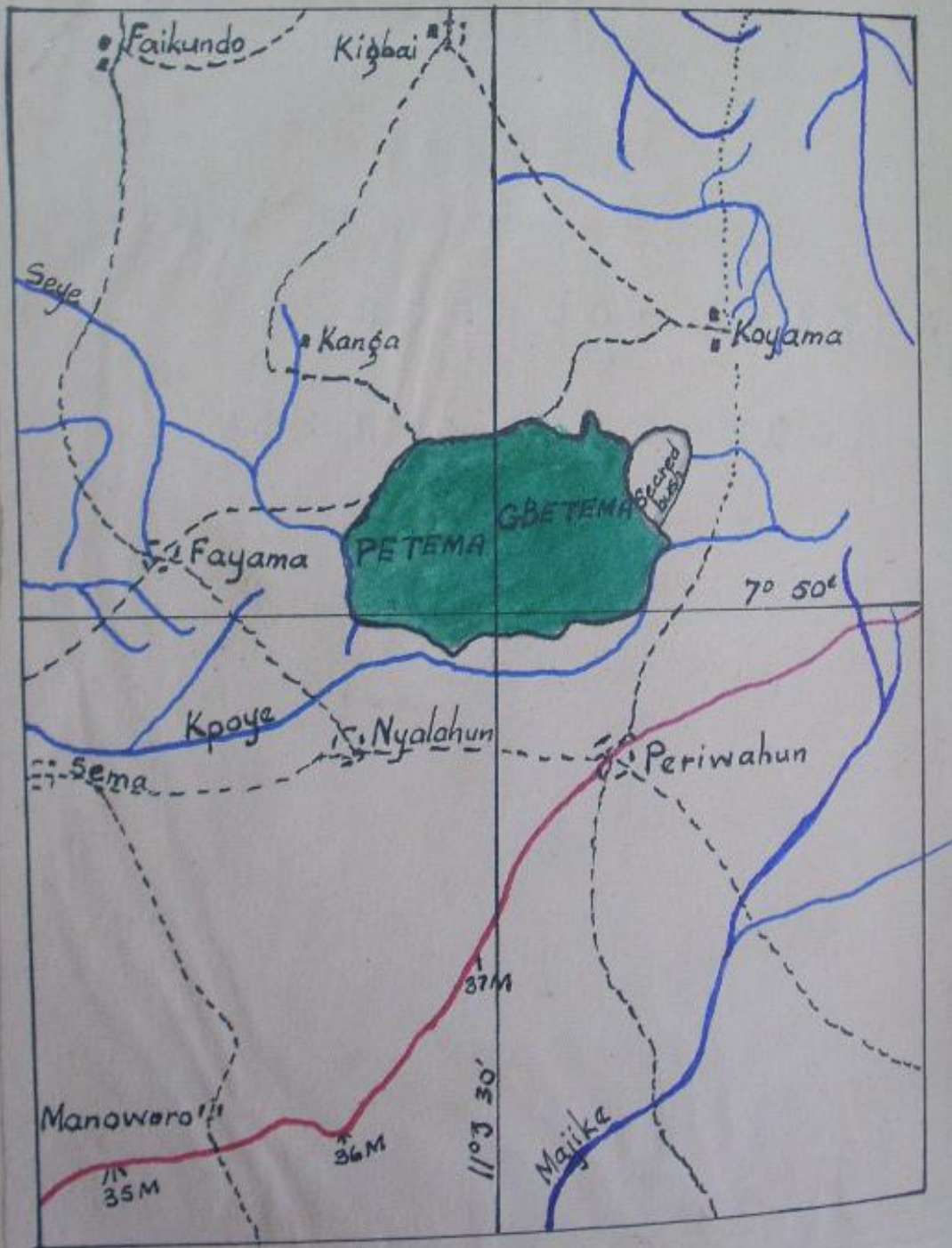

THE FORESTRY ORDINANCE
(Cap. 86)

THE FORESTRY (JAIAMA-BONGOR PROTECTED FOREST No. 1)
ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1959

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Paramount Chief and Tribal Authority of the Jaiama-Bongor Chiefdom in the Bo District of the South-western Province of the Protectorate of Sierra Leone:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Jaiama-Bongor Protected Forest No. 1) Order in Council, 1959.
2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT PIECE OF LAND comprising approximately 1 square mile in the Jaiama-Bongor Chiefdom of the Bo District in the South-western Province of the Protectorate of Sierra Leone and bounded as follows—

Starting from Boundary Mark No. 1 which is situated at a point 0.06 chain from the south side of the Koyama to Tayama road and 0.1 chain from the eastern bank of Halayei Stream and at a distance of 0.3 chain on a bearing of 188 degrees from the chiefdom boundary stone, and thence by a series of cut and beacons lines as shown in the following table:—

(2) Measurements are in Gunter's chains of 66 feet.

(3) All Boundary Marks referred to above are stone cairns.
