THE FORESTRY ORDINANCE
(Cap. 86)

THE FORESTRY (KAFU BULLOM PROTECTED FOREST No. 1)
ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1955

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Tribal Authority of the Kafu Bullom Chiefdom in the Port Loko District of the Northern Province of the Protectorate of Sierra Leone:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Kafu Bullom Protected Forest No. 1) Order in Council, 1955.
2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT PIECE OF LAND, comprising 127 acres or thereabouts, situated in the Kafu Bullom Chiefdom in the Port Loko District of the Northern Province of the Protectorate of Sierra Leone and bounded as follows:—

SOUTH—

Starting from Boundary Stone No. 1 which is a Stone cairn situated on the southern edge of the Gbombali Mangrove Swamp and the western side of the motor road from Rogbombali to Rogbonko; thence by the northern side of the said motor road in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 83.61 chains to Boundary Stone No. 2, which is situated on the northern side of the said motor road; thence

WEST—

by a demarcated line cut on a bearing of $358^{\circ}00'$ for a distance of 8.85 chains to Boundary Stone No. 3, which is situated on the south-eastern edge of an un-named swamp; thence

NORTH—

by the southern edge of the said swamp in a north-easterly direction to Boundary Stone No. 4, which is distant 60.30 chains measured in a straight line on a bearing of $34^{\circ}30'$ from Boundary Stone No. 3; thence

EAST—

by the southern edge of the Gbombali Mangrove Swamp, in a south-easterly direction to Boundary Stone No. 5, which is distant 34.6 chains measured in a straight line on a bearing of $164^{\circ}15'$ from Boundary Stone No. 4; thence by the southern edge of the said swamp in a north-easterly direction to Boundary Stone No. 1 which is the starting point, and distant 26.6 chains measured in a straight line on a bearing of $68^{\circ}00'$ from Boundary Stone No. 5.

As the same is more particularly delineated on Forest Department Plan No. BA. 56 and is shown thereon verged GREEN.

Note.—

- (1) All bearings given above are magnetic bearings taken in the year 1953 and are approximate.
- (2) All distances given above are in Gunter's chains of 66 feet and are approximate.
- (3) All Boundary Stones mentioned above are stone cairns.
