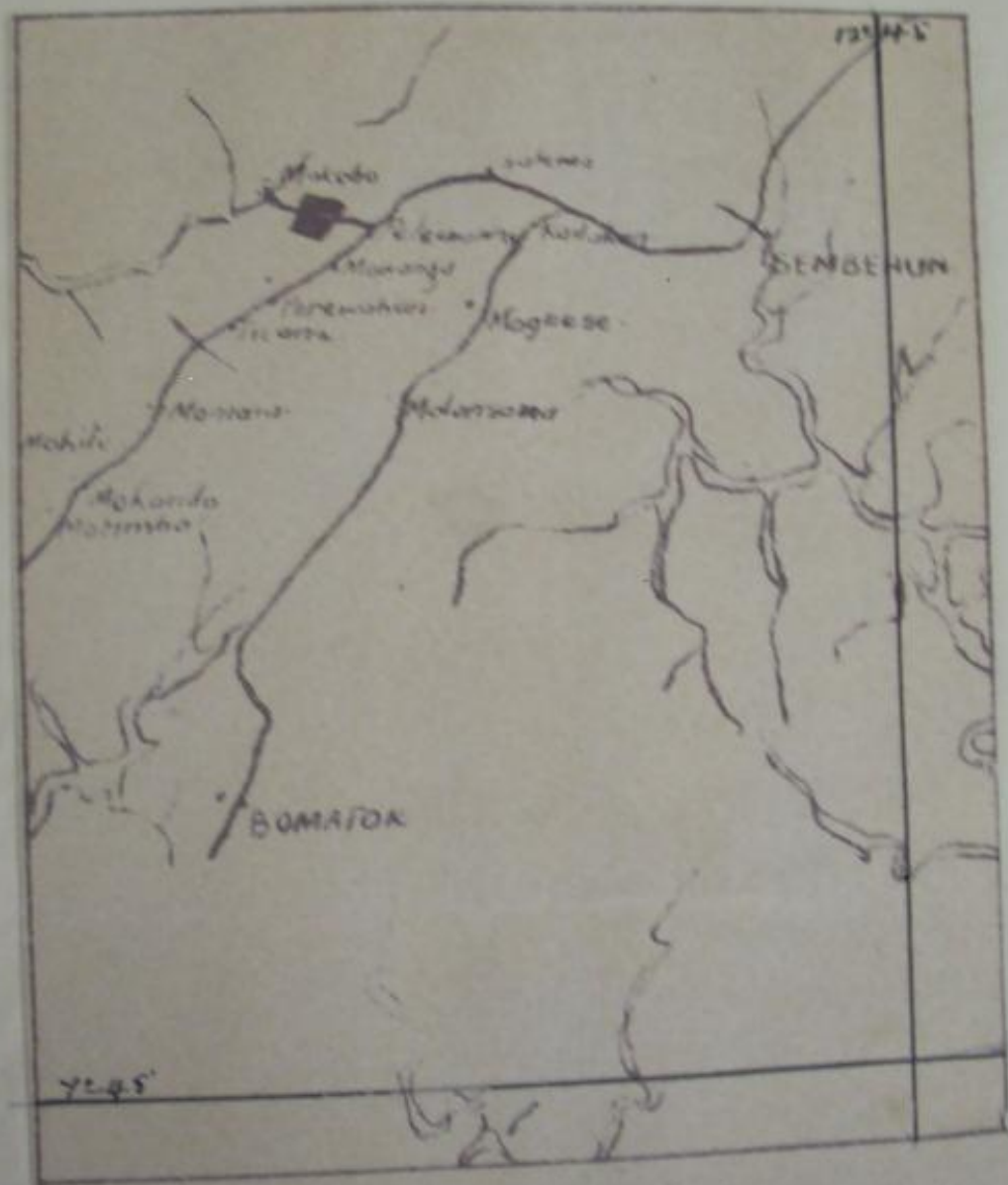

THE FORESTRY ORDINANCE
(Cap. 86)

THE FORESTRY (KAGBORO PROTECTED FOREST No. 2)
ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1957

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Tribal Authority of the Kagboro Chiefdom, Moyamba District, South-western Province:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Kagboro Protected Forest No. 2) Order in Council, 1957.

2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance—

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT LAND comprising 19 acres or thereabout bounded by a cleared trace and lying within 220 feet on either side of the centre of the motor road from Sembahun to Mokobo in the Kagboro Chiefdom in the Moyamba District of the South-western Province of the Protectorate of Sierra Leone starting at a point about 4,544 feet from Petewoma junction and ending at a point some 2,404 feet westwards from the starting point along the said motor road; the end point being also 3,972 feet eastwards from the left bank of the Kagboro River along the said road, provided that the following area shall be excluded from the Protected Forest—

50 feet on either side of the Motor Road.

As the same is illustrated on Forestry Department Plan No. Bo 151 in the office of the Chief Conservator of Forests, Freetown and of the Divisional Forest Officer, Bo, and is shown thereon verged GREEN.
