

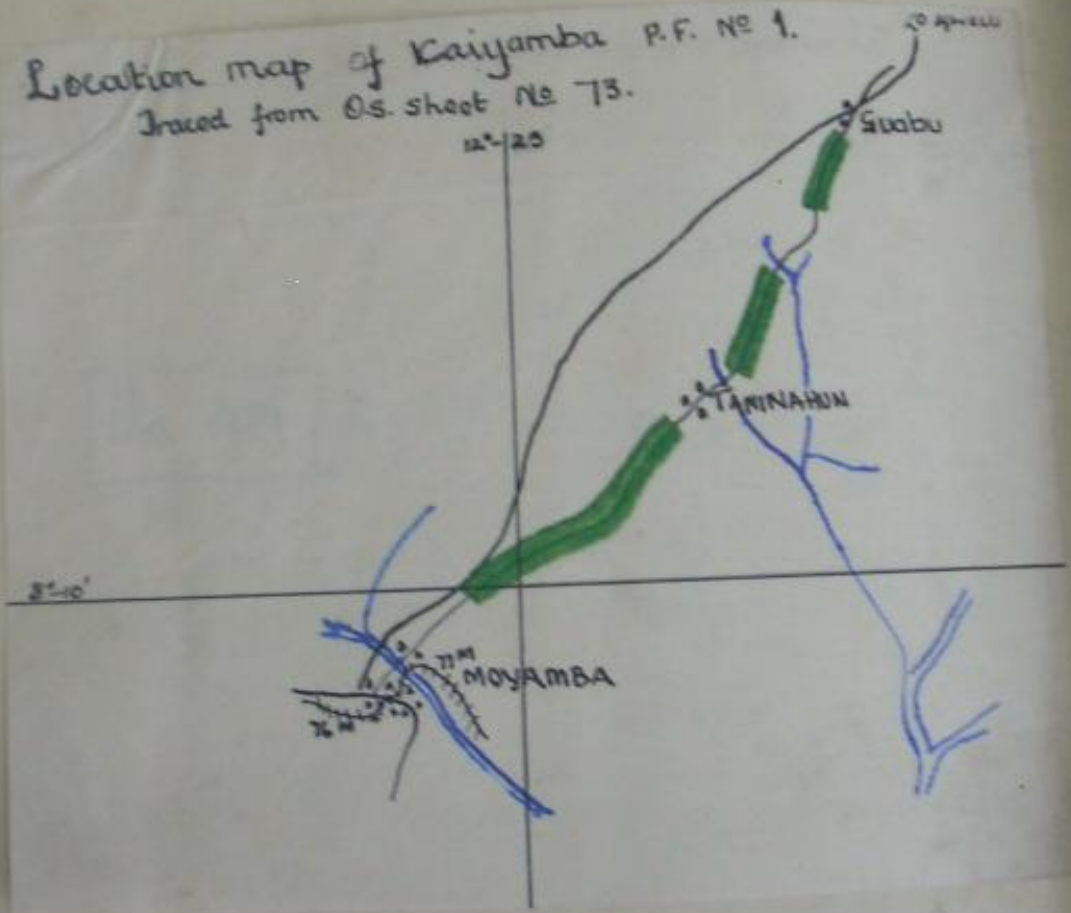

THE FORESTRY ORDINANCE
(Cap. 86)

FORESTRY (KAIYAMBA NATIVE ADMINISTRATION PROTECTED FOREST No.1)
ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1950.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by Section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Paramount Chief and members of the Tribal Authority of the Kaiyamba Chiefdom, Moyamba District, South-Western Province.

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Kaiyamba Native Administration Protected Forest No.1) Order in Council, 1950.
2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT LAND comprising 116 acres or thereabouts, bounded by a cleared trace and lying within 200 feet on either side of the centre of the hammock path from Moyamba to Ewelu in the Kaiyamba Division in the Moyamba District of the South-Western Province of the Protectorate of Sierra Leone, starting at a point distant about 1,120 feet north-east of Railway milestone 76/111 and ending at a point about 1,120 feet south of the intersection of the said hammock path with the Moyamba to Kasewe road, provided that the following areas shall be excluded from the Protected Forest:-

Between points distant about 5,270 feet and 8,460 feet on the southern side of the hammock path and 5,930 feet and 8,460 feet on the northern side, which includes Bossnesi and Taninahun villages.

Between points distant about 11,760 feet and 12,120 feet from the starting point, which includes the Pofayei river and swamp.

As the same is more particularly delineated on plan No. 1/50 in the office of the Divisional Forest Officer, Bo, and shown thereon verged GREEN.
