LOCATION MAP OF KAIYAMBA P.F. NO 2

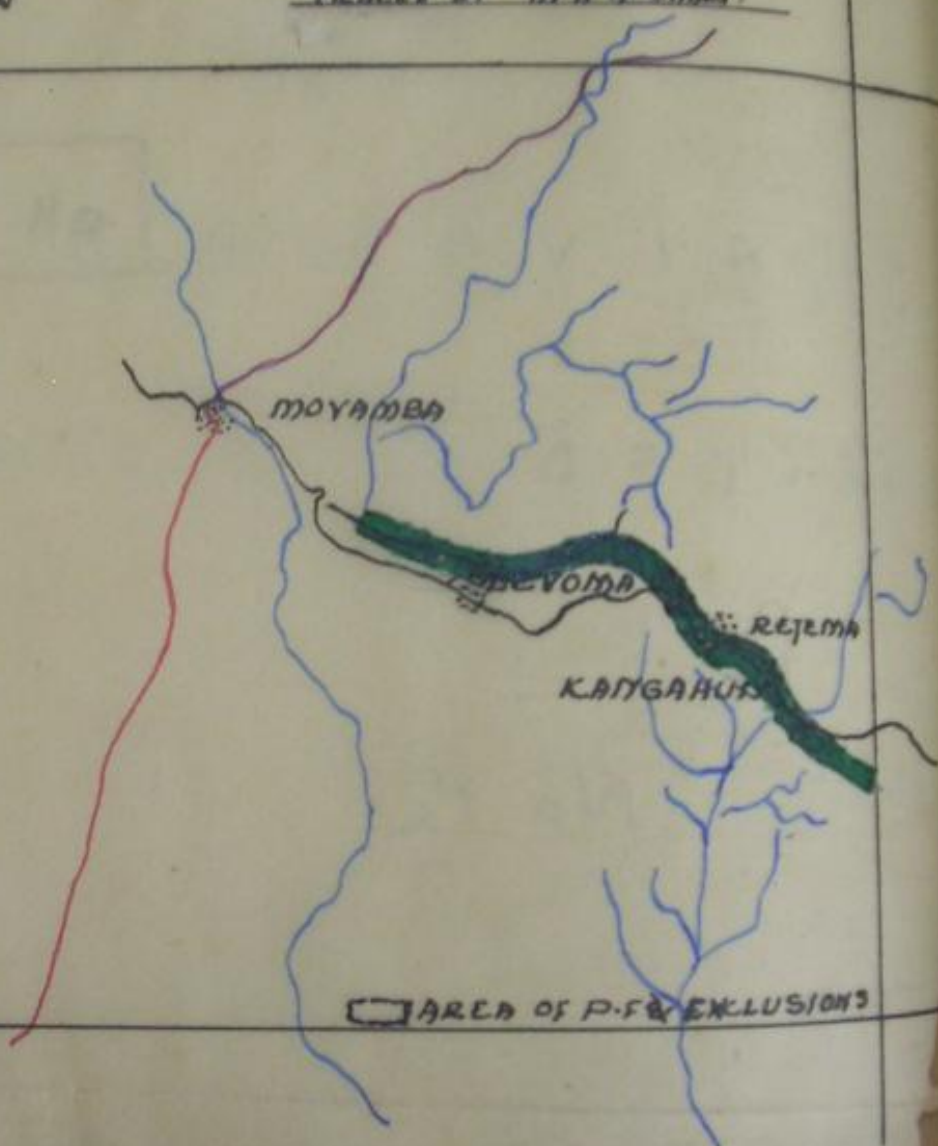

THE FORESTRY ORDINANCE  
(Cap. 86)

THE FORESTRY (KAIYAMBA NATIVE ADMINISTRATION PROTECTED FOREST No.2)  
ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1950.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by Section 14 of The Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Paramount Chief and members of the Tribal Authority of the Kaiyamba Chiefdom, Moyamba District, South-western Province.

1. This Order may be cited as The Forestry (Kaiyamba Native Administration Protected Forest No.2) Order in Council, 1950.
2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT LAND comprising 295 acres or thereabouts, bounded by a cleared track and lying within 200 feet on either side of the centre of the hammock path from Lungi to Taninahun in the Kaiyamba Chiefdom in the Moyamba District of the Protectorate of Sierra Leone, starting on the northern side of the hammock path at a point about 14,000 feet east of the left bank of the Gbangbala river and on the southern side of the hammock path at a point about 19,766 feet east of the same river and ending on the northern side at a point about 4,000 feet east of the intersection of the hammock path with the railway line at Petem and on the southern side at the point where the hammock path crosses the boundary between Kaiyamba and Desse Chiefdoms; provided that the following areas shall be excluded from the Protected Forest:-

Between points distant about 31,670 feet and 33,860 feet from the left bank of the Gbangbala river, which includes Bembuibu village and a swamp.

Between points distant about 42,540 feet and 43,014 feet from the left bank of the Gbangbala river, which includes a swamp.

Between points distant about 45,550 feet and 48,860 feet from the left bank of the Gbangbala river on the southern side of the hammock path, which includes Petem village and Railway property.

Between points distant about 53,070 feet and 56,860 feet from the left bank of the Gbangbala river on the southern side of the hammock path, which includes Kangahun village.

Between points distant about 59,600 feet and 63,334 feet from the left bank of the Gbangbala river, which includes Railway property.

As the same is more particularly delineated on plan No. 10/50 in the Office of the Divisional Forest Officer No. 2, and thereon verged GREEN.
