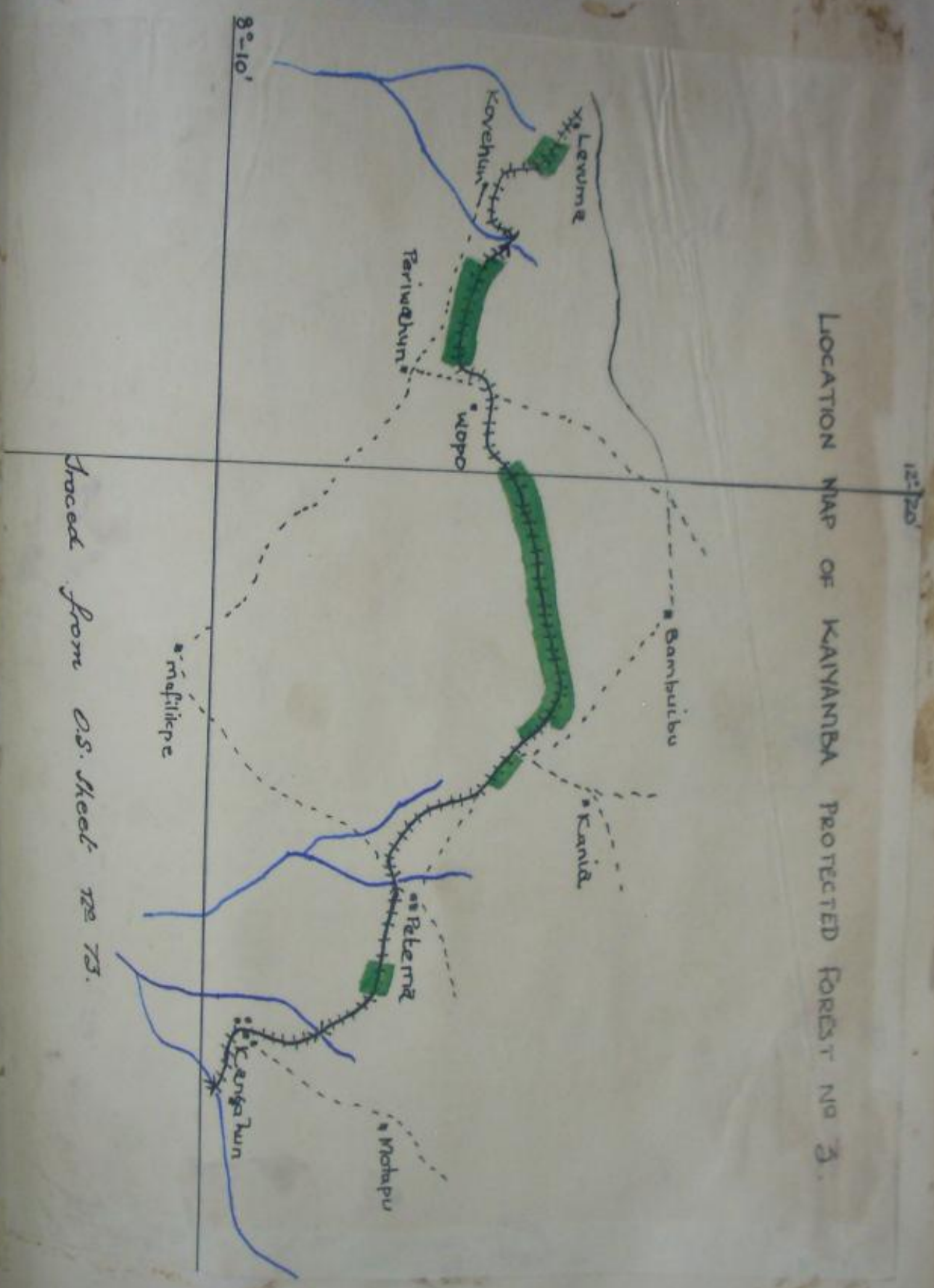

**THE FORESTRY ORDINANCE**  
(Cap. 86)

**THE FORESTRY (KAIYAMBA NATIVE ADMINISTRATION PROTECTED FOREST NO. 3) ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1951**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by Section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Paramount Chief and members of the Tribal Authority of the Kaiyamba Chiefdom, Moyamba District, South-western Province.

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Kaiyamba Native Administration Protected Forest No. 3) Order in Council, 1951.

2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

**SCHEDULE**

ALL THAT LAND comprising 218 acres or thereabouts bounded by a cleared trace and lying within 260 feet on either side of the centre of the railway line from Levuma to Kangahun in the Kaiyamba Chiefdom of the Moyamba District of the South-western Province of the Protectorate of Sierra Leone, starting at railway milestone 83/i and ceasing about 1,170 feet east of railway milestone 90/i provided that the following areas shall be excluded from the Protected Forest:—

All that land which lies within 33 feet on either side of the centre of the railway line, which is Railway property.

Between points distant about 2,183 feet and 4,720 feet from the starting point on the northern side of the railway line and 2,183 feet and 5,050 feet on the southern side of the railway line, which includes Petema Village and swamp.

Between points distant about 10,100 feet and 14,045 feet from the starting point, which includes Wopo Village and swamp.

Between points distant about 22,220 feet and 24,310 feet from the starting point on the northern side of the railway line, which includes an unnamed swamp.

Between points distant about 26,260 feet and 34,400 feet from the starting point on the northern side of the railway line and 23,570 feet and 34,400 feet on the southern side of the railway line, which includes Petema Village and swamp.

The above area is more particularly delineated on Plan No. Bo 11/50 lodged in the office of the Divisional Forest Officer, Bo, and shown thereon verged GREEN.
