KAIYAMBA No. 6.

1. This Order may be cited as the Kaiyamba No. 6 Protected Forest Order.

2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a protected forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

SCHEDULE.

All that land, comprising 239 acres or thereabouts, bounded by a cleared track and lying within 260 feet on either side of the centre of the railway line from Moyamba to Bauya in the Kaiyamba Chiefdom of the Moyamba District of the South-Western Province of the Protectorate of Sierra Leone, starting about 200 feet east of railway milestone 69, and ending on the northern side of the railway line 420 feet west of railway milestone 75/ii and, on the southern side, at railway milestone 74/iii:

Provided that the following areas shall be excluded from the protected forest:

All that land which lies within 33 feet on either side of the centre of the railway line which is railway property.

Between points distant about 5,080 feet and 15,140 feet from the starting point on the northern side of the railway line, and 5,080 feet

and 9,040 feet and 10,880 feet and 11,200 feet on the southern side of the railway line, which includes Yoyama Village and swamp.

Between points distant about 15,110 feet and 17,580 feet from the starting point on the southern side of the railway line, which includes railway buildings.

The above area is more particularly delineated on Plan No. Bc 1480 lodged in the office of the Divisional Forest Officer, Ba., and shown thereon as **VERTED GREEN**.
