Short title. THE FORESTRY KAKUA No. 3 PROTECTED FOREST DECONSTITUTION ORDER, 1973

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 15 of the Forestry Act the President acting in accordance with the advice of the Cabinet hereby makes the following Order:—

1. The Lands constituted a Protected Forest by the Kakua No. 3 Protected Forest Order described in the Schedule hereto shall cease to be a protected forest with effect from the 23rd day of October, 1973.

SCHEDULE

All that land comprising 20 acres or thereabouts bounded by a cleared trace and lying within 210 feet on either side of the centre of the motor road from Bo to Tikonko, in the Bo District of the Southern Province of Sierra Leone, commencing about 696 feet in a south-westerly direction from Milestone 1 on the said motor road and ending at about 816 feet in a south-westerly direction from Milestone 2 on the said motor road which is the boundary between Kakua and Tikonko Chiefdoms:

Provided that the following areas shall be excluded from the Protected Forest now constituted—

Between points distant about 730 feet and 2,420 from the starting point, which includes an unnamed swamp.

On the West side between points distant about 2,420 feet and 5,400 feet from the starting point which includes the Bo Landing Strip.

As the same is more particularly delineated on Plan No. 18/50 in the office of the Divisional Forest Officer, Bo, and shown thereon verged GREEN.
