THE FORESTRY ORDINANCE
(Cap. 86)

THE FORESTRY (KASE PROTECTED FOREST No. 1)
ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1954

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance and at the request of the Tribal Authority of the Kase Chiefdom, Port Loko District, Northern Province, the following Order is hereby made:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Kase Protected Forest No. 1) Order in Council, 1954.

2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT PIECE OF LAND, comprising 131 acres or thereabouts situated in the Kase Chiefdom in the Port Loko District of the Northern Province, and bounded as follows:—

Starting from Boundary Stone No. 1 which is a stone cairn situated on the right or northern bank of the Kibono stream and distant about 8.50 chains measured in a straight line on a bearing of approximately $298^{\circ}30'$ from the north-western corner of a concrete bridge over the said stream on the Makeni to Port Loko motor road; thence downstream by the right or northern bank of the said stream to Boundary Stone No. 2, which is distant about 33.50 chains measured in a straight line on a bearing of approximately $276^{\circ}30'$ from Boundary Stone No. 1; thence by a demarcated line cut on a bearing of approximately $14^{\circ}00'$ for a distance of about 48.43 chains to Boundary Stone No. 3, which is situated on the southern edge of an un-named swamp; thence by the edge of the said swamp, in a north-easterly direction to Boundary stone No. 4 which is situated on the western side of the Romeni to Petifu footpath, and distant about 10.50 chains measured in a straight line, on a bearing of approximately $66^{\circ}30'$ from Boundary Stone No. 3; thence by the western side of the said footpath in a south-easterly direction to Boundary Stone No. 5 which is situated on the southern side of the Romeni to Mabure footpath, and distant about 44.80 chains measured in a straight line on a bearing of approximately $154^{\circ}00'$ from Boundary Stone No. 4; thence

by the northern side of the said footpath in a south-westerly direction to Boundary Stone No. 6, and distant about 5.50 chains measured in a straight line on a bearing of approximately $251^{\circ}00'$ from Boundary Stone No. 5; thence by a demarcated line cut on a bearing of approximately $190^{\circ}30'$ for a distance of about 13.14 chains to Boundary Stone No. 1 which is the starting point.

As the same is illustrated on Plan No. BA. 58 in the office of the Chief Conservator of Forests, Freetown, and of the Divisional Forest Officer, Batkanu, and is shown thereon verged GREEN.

Note:

- (1) All bearings given above are magnetic bearings taken in the year 1952.
- (2) All distances given are in Gunter's chains of 66 feet.
- (3) All Boundary Stones given above are stone cairns.
