THE FORESTRY (KONDEMBABA ROADSIDE PROTECTED FOREST) ORDER IN COUNCIL

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, an Order is hereby made at the request of the Tribal Authorities of the Diang and Wara Wara Yagala commencing a Roadside Protected Forest No. 1) Order

- 1) This Order may be cited as the Roadside Protected Forest No. 1) Order
- 2) The lands described in the Schedule hereby constituted a Protected Forest with effect from the date of the Forestry Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

All that land comprising 465 acres on the left hand side of and within 710 feet of the main road from Kabala to Kondembaba Diang and Wara Wara Yagala commencing along the centre of the road from Kabala to Makeni and ending at the junction of the main road in the direction of Kondembaba, perches shall be excluded from the Protected Forest.

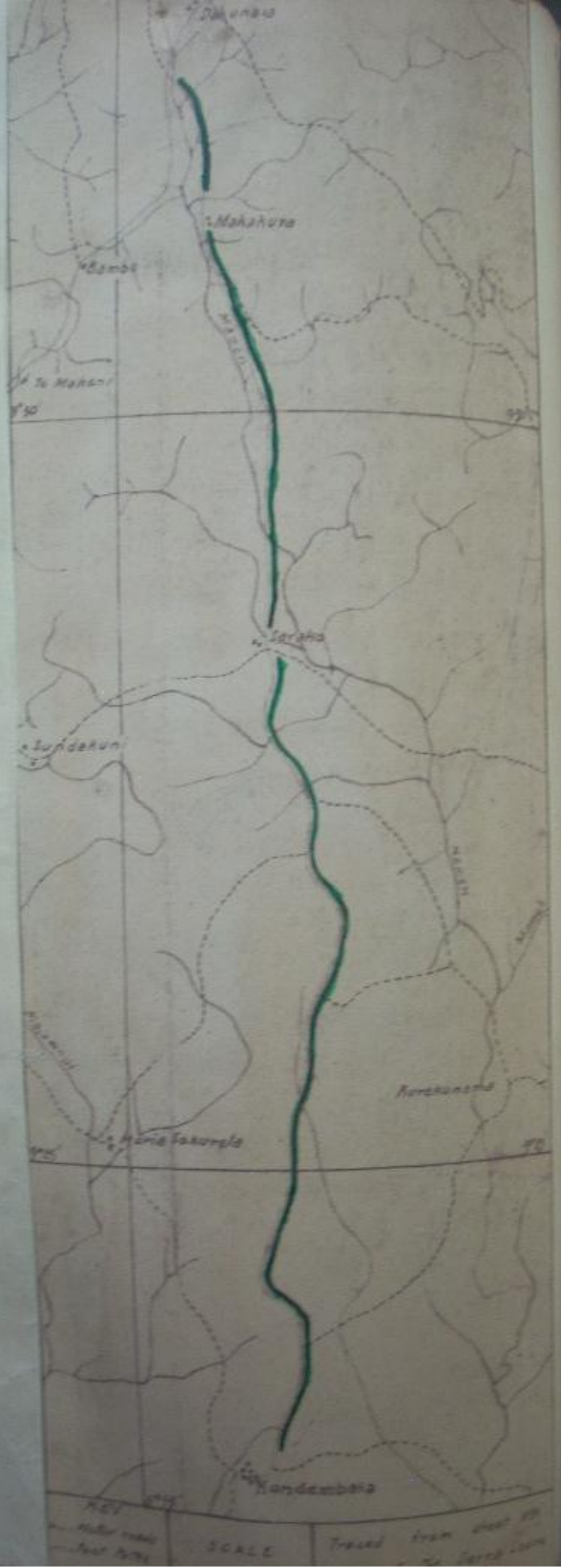

THE FORESTRY (KONDEMBAIA ROADSIDE PROTECTED FOREST No. 1)
ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1957

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Paramount Chiefs and the Tribal Authorities of the Diang and Wara Yagala Chiefdoms, Kono District, Northern Province:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Kondembaia Roadside Protected Forest No. 1) Order in Council, 1957.

2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT LAND comprising 465 acres or thereabouts lying on the left hand side of and within 710 feet of the centre of the motor road from Kabala to Kondembaia in the chiefdoms of Diang and Wara Yagala commencing at about 40 chains measured along the centre of the road in the direction of Kondembaia from the junction of the said road with the road from Kabala to Makeni and ending at a stone cairn about 773 chains from the starting point measured along the centre of the road in the direction of Kondembaia, provided that the following areas shall be excluded from the Protected Forest—

(i) All those areas of land lying within 710 feet of and on the left hand side of the centre of the road as defined in the following table—
