**THE FORESTRY ORDINANCE**  
(Cap. 86)

**THE FORESTRY (KONGBORA NATIVE ADMINISTRATION PROTECTED  
FOREST NO. 1) ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1950**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Paramount Chief and members of the Tribal Authority of the Kongbora Chiefdom, Moyamba District, South-western Province.

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Kongbora Native Administration Protected Forest No. 1) Order in Council, 1950.

2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

**SCHEDULE**

ALL THAT PIECE OF LAND comprising 47.8 acres or thereabouts, bounded by a cleared trace and lying within 210 feet on either side of the centre of the main hammock path from Rokunk to Gibini in the Kongbora Chiefdom in the Moyamba District of the South-western Province of Sierra Leone, starting at a point about 1,052 feet east of the Mamboi Stream and ceasing at a point 310 feet west of the Bagbe or Kikili Stream. Provided that the following areas shall be excluded from the Protected Forest:—

Between points about 3,022 feet and about 4,050 feet distance from the Mamboi Stream, which includes the Jeneh Swamp.

Between points about 5,040 feet and about 5,841 feet distance from the Mamboi Stream on the southern side of the path, which includes Jeneh Village and the sacred bush.
