The Forestry Ordinance, 1924.

M.P. 5180/36 4

The Forestry (Korigbua Hill Protected Forest) Order in Council, 1947.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, 1924, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Paramount Chief and with the authority of the Lunia Chiefdom :-

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Korigbua Hill Protected Forest) Order in Council, 1947.

2. The lands described in the Schedule to this order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance, 1924.

SCHEDULE.

All that area of land enclosed within the following boundaries :-

Starting from Boundary Stone No. 1 which is at the point of confluence of a small unnamed stream with the river Teye approximately 150 yards to the South-East of Kungari New Town and proceeding thence up this unnamed stream for a distance of 165 yards to Boundary Stone No. 2; thence on a magnetic bearing of 60 degrees to Boundary Stone No. 3, a distance of 35 yards; thence on a magnetic bearing of 27 degrees to Boundary Stone No. 4 a distance of 107 yards; thence on a magnetic bearing of 332 degrees to Boundary Stone No. 5 a distance of 42 yards; thence along the Harco Company's motor road which runs between Kungari and Beomahan to Boundary Stone No. 6 a distance of 924 yards; thence on a magnetic bearing of 200 degrees to Boundary Stone No. 7, a distance of 878 yards; thence on a magnetic bearing of 207 degrees to Boundary Stone No. 8, a distance of 248 yards; thence on a magnetic bearing of 241 degrees to Boundary Stone No. 9 which is on the bank of the River Teye, a distance of 585 yards; thence down the River Teye to Boundary Stone No. 1 described above which is the starting point. Land within these areas occupied by existing houses and compounds, roads, bush and swamps shall be excluded.
