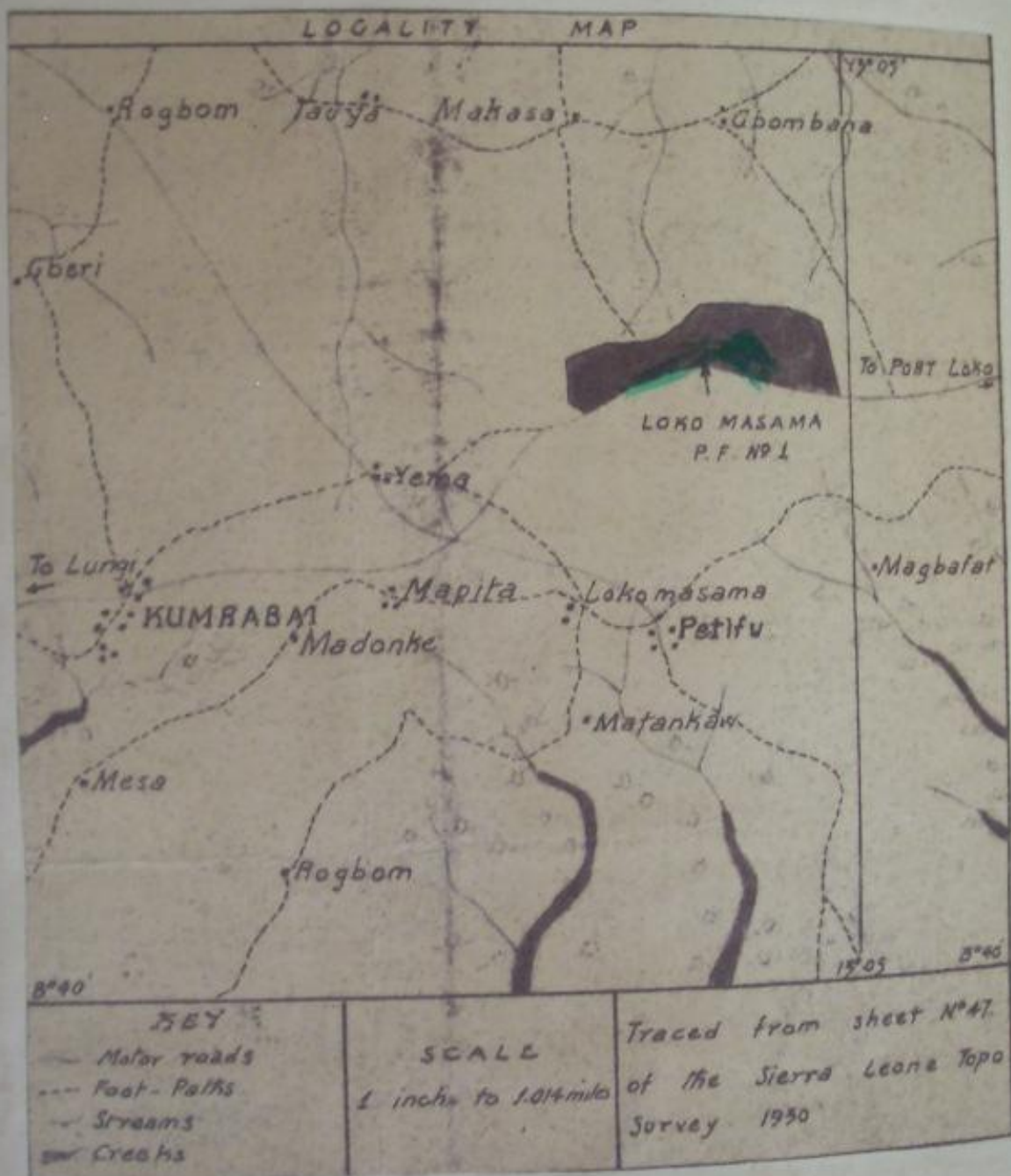

THE FORESTRY ORDINANCE
(Cap. 86)

THE FORESTRY (LOKO MASAMA PROTECTED FOREST No. 1) ORDER
IN COUNCIL, 1954

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made, at the request of the Paramount Chief and Tribal Authority of the Loko Masama Chiefdom, Port Loko District, Northern Province:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Loko Masama Protected Forest No. 1) Order in Council, 1954.

2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT PIECE OF LAND, comprising 148 acres or thereabouts, situated in the Loko Masama Chiefdom in the Port Loko District of the Northern Province of the Protectorate of Sierra Leone and bounded as follows:—

Starting from Boundary Stone No. 1, which is a stone cairn situated on the northern side of the motor road from Port Loko to Lungi, and distant 13.01 chains in a westerly direction from Milestone 26 on the said motor road; thence by a series of cut and beacons lines as shown in the following table:—

From Boundary Stone No.	To Boundary Stone No.	Bearing (degrees)	Distance in chains
1	2	306	5.42
2	3	353½	10.18
3	4	91½	8.22
4	5	97½	9.20

Boundary Stone No. 5 is situated on the southern edge of an unnamed swamp; thence by the edge of the swamp to boundary stone No. 6, which is distant 22.60 chains, measured in a straight line on a bearing of fifty-eight degrees from Boundary Stone No. 5; thence by a series of cut and beacons lines as shown in the following table:—

From Boundary Stone No.	To Boundary Stone No.	Bearing (degrees)	Distance in Chains
6	7	96½	40.41
7	8	117½	17.69
8	9	175	22.53

Boundary Stone No. 9 is Milestone 25 on the Port Loko to Lungi motor road and is situated on the northern side of the said road; thence by the northern side of the said motor road in a westerly direction for a distance of 94.81 chains to Boundary Stone No. 1 which is the starting point.

As the same is illustrated on Plan No. BA. 57 in the office of the Chief Conservator of Forests, Freetown, and of the Divisional Forest Officer, Batkanu, and is shown thereon verged GREEN.

Note.—(1) All bearing given are approximate magnetic bearings taken in the year 1953.

(2) All distances given above are approximate and are measured in Gunter's chains of 66 feet.

(3) All Boundary Stones given above are stone cairns.
