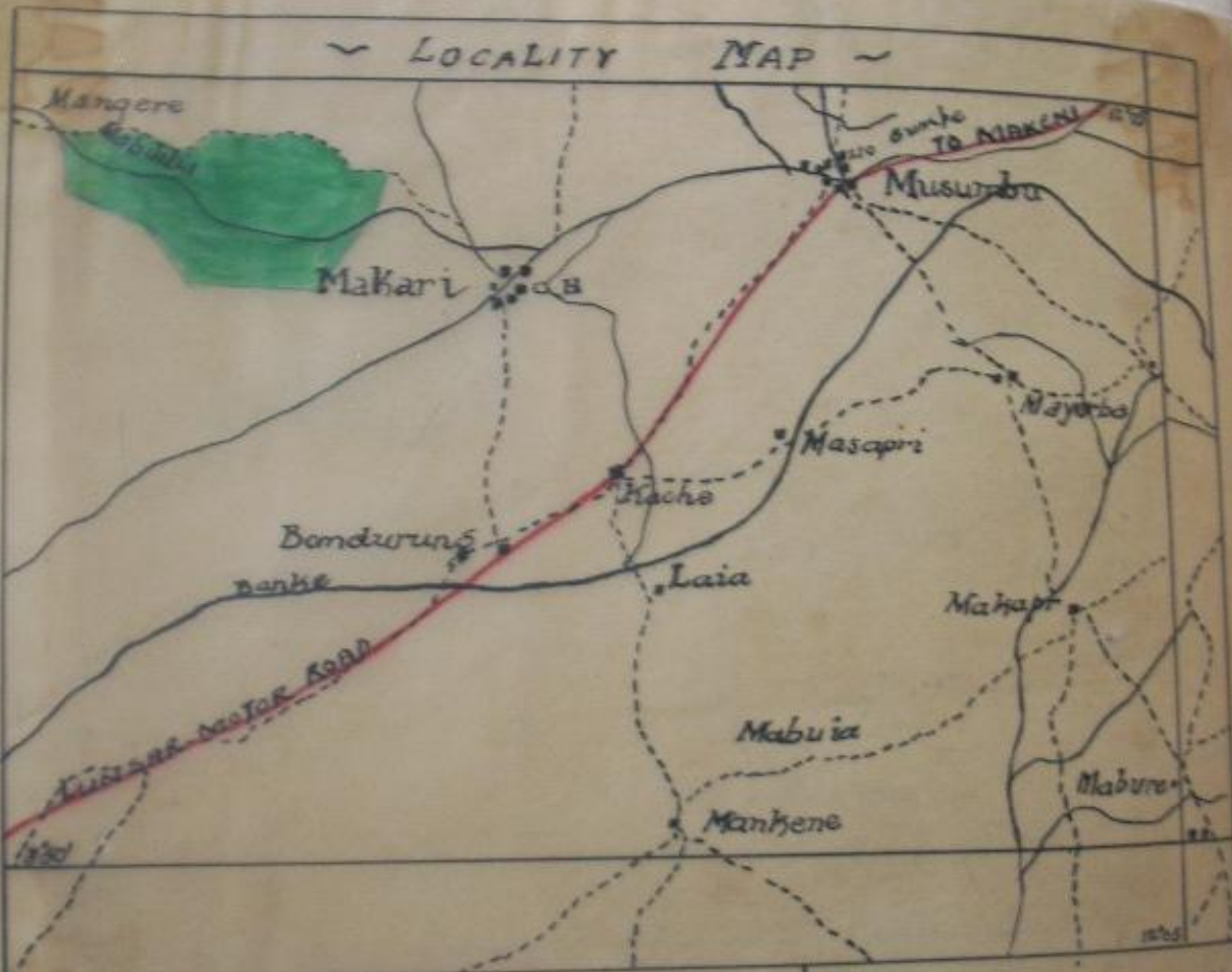

THE FORESTRY ORDINANCE
(Cap. 86)

THE FORESTRY (MAKARI PROTECTED FOREST) ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1954

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Paramount Chief and Tribal Authority of the Makari-Gbanti Chiefdom, Bombali District, Northern Province:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Makari Protected Forest) Order in Council, 1954.

2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT PIECE OF LAND, comprising 496 acres or thereabouts, situated in the Makari-Gbanti Chiefdom in the Bombali District of the Northern Province of the Protectorate of Sierra Leone and bounded as follows:—

EAST:

Starting from Boundary Mark No. 1, which is a stone cairn situated on the southern side of the Makeni-Lunsar hammock trail, and at a point about 27.00 chains in a westerly direction from a second point on the said road, which is distant about 1.00 chains at right angles to the south-eastern corner of the house of the Headman of Makari Town; thence by a demarcated line cut on a bearing of approximately $212^{\circ}15'$ for a distance of 13.01 chains to Boundary Mark No. 2; thence

SOUTH:

by a demarcated line cut on a bearing of approximately $269^{\circ}30'$ for a distance of about 48.52 chains to Boundary Mark No. 3; thence

WEST:

by a demarcated line cut on a bearing of approximately $336^{\circ}45'$ for a distance of about 60.93 chains to Boundary Mark No. 4, which is situated on the northern side of the Makeni-Lunsar hammock trail; thence by the northern

side of the hammock trail for a distance of about 28.45 chains in a north-westerly direction to Boundary Mark No. 5; thence by a demarcated line cut on a bearing of approximately $7^{\circ}30'$ for a distance of about 19.29 chains to Boundary Mark No. 6, which is situated on the left bank of the Mabuillia stream; thence

NORTH:

upstream by the southern bank of the said stream in a south-easterly direction to Boundary Mark No. 7 which is distant about 121.00 chains, measured in a straight line, from Boundary Mark No. 6; thence by a demarcated line cut on a bearing of approximately $130^{\circ}30'$ for a distance of about 5.18 chains to Boundary Mark No. 8 thence

EAST:

by a demarcated line cut on a bearing of approximately $212^{\circ}00'$ for a distance of about 10.60 chains to Boundary Mark No. 1 which is the starting point.

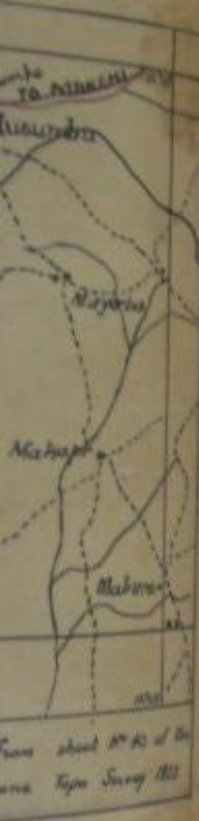
As the same is more particularly delineated on Plan No. BA.43 in the office of the Divisional Forest Officer, Batkano, and is shown thereon verged GREEN.

1. All measurements given above are in Gunter's Chains of 66 feet.
2. All bearings given above are magnetic bearings taken in the year 1951.
3. All Boundary Marks mentioned above are Stone Cairns.
