THE FORESTRY ORDINANCE
(Cap. 86)

THE FORESTRY (MARAMPA-MASIMERA PROTECTED FOREST No. 2)
ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1955

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Tribal Authority of the Marampa-Masimera Chiefdom, Port Loko District, Northern Province:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Marampa-Masimera Protected Forest No. 2) Order in Council, 1955.
2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT LAND, comprising 234 acres or thereabouts situate and lying within the Marampa-Masimera Chiefdom in the Port Loko District of the Northern Province of the Protectorate of Sierra Leone and bounded as follows:—

Starting from Boundary Stone No. 1, which is a stone cairn situated on the southern side of the footpath from Masetle to the Lunsar to Port Loko motor road at the point where the said footpath joins the said motor road, which is distant 39.40 chains measured in a straight line on a bearing of 334 degrees from mile-stone 11 on the said motor road; thence by the southern side of the said footpath, in a north-easterly direction to Boundary Stone No. 2, which is distant 20.35 chains measured in a straight line on a bearing of 61½ degrees from Boundary Stone No. 1; thence by a demarcated line cut on a bearing of 105½ degrees for a distance of 24.62 chains to Boundary Stone No. 3, which is situated on the western side of the footpath from Masetle to Madigbo; thence by the south-western side of the said footpath in a south-easterly direction to Boundary Stone No. 4, which is distant 22.10 chains measured in a straight line on a bearing of 128½ degrees from Boundary Stone No. 3; thence by a demarcated line cut on a bearing of 192 degrees for a distance of 30.28 chains to Boundary Stone No. 5; thence by a demarcated line cut on a bearing of 220 degrees for a distance of 16.92 chains to Boundary Stone No. 6, which is situated on the northern side of the motor road from Lunsar to Port Loko; thence by the north-eastern side of the said motor road in a north-westerly direction to Boundary Stone No. 1, which is the starting point and distant 67.50 chains measured in a straight line on a bearing of 322½ degrees from Boundary Stone No. 6. Provided that the following areas lying within the Protected Forest shall be set aside for agricultural purposes:—

- (a) All that land lying within 2.50 chains on the north-easterly side of the centre of the motor road from Lunsar to Port Loko commencing at Boundary Stone No. 6 and ending at Boundary Stone No. 1.
- (b) All areas of land which in the wet season become swamp.

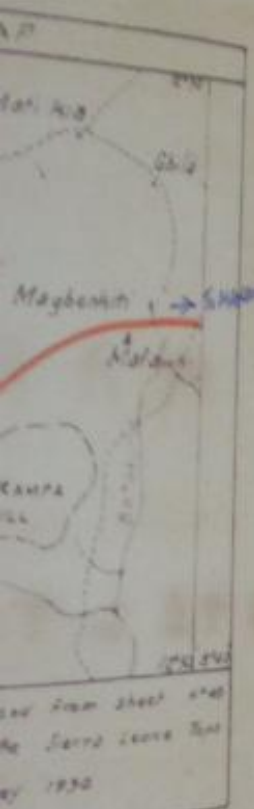
As the same is illustrated on Forest Department Plan No. BA 59 and is shown thereon verged GREEN.

- (i) All bearings given above are approximate magnetic bearings taken in the year 1953.
- (ii) All distances given above are approximate in Gunter's chains of 66 feet.
- (iii) All Boundary Stones given above are stone cairns.
