

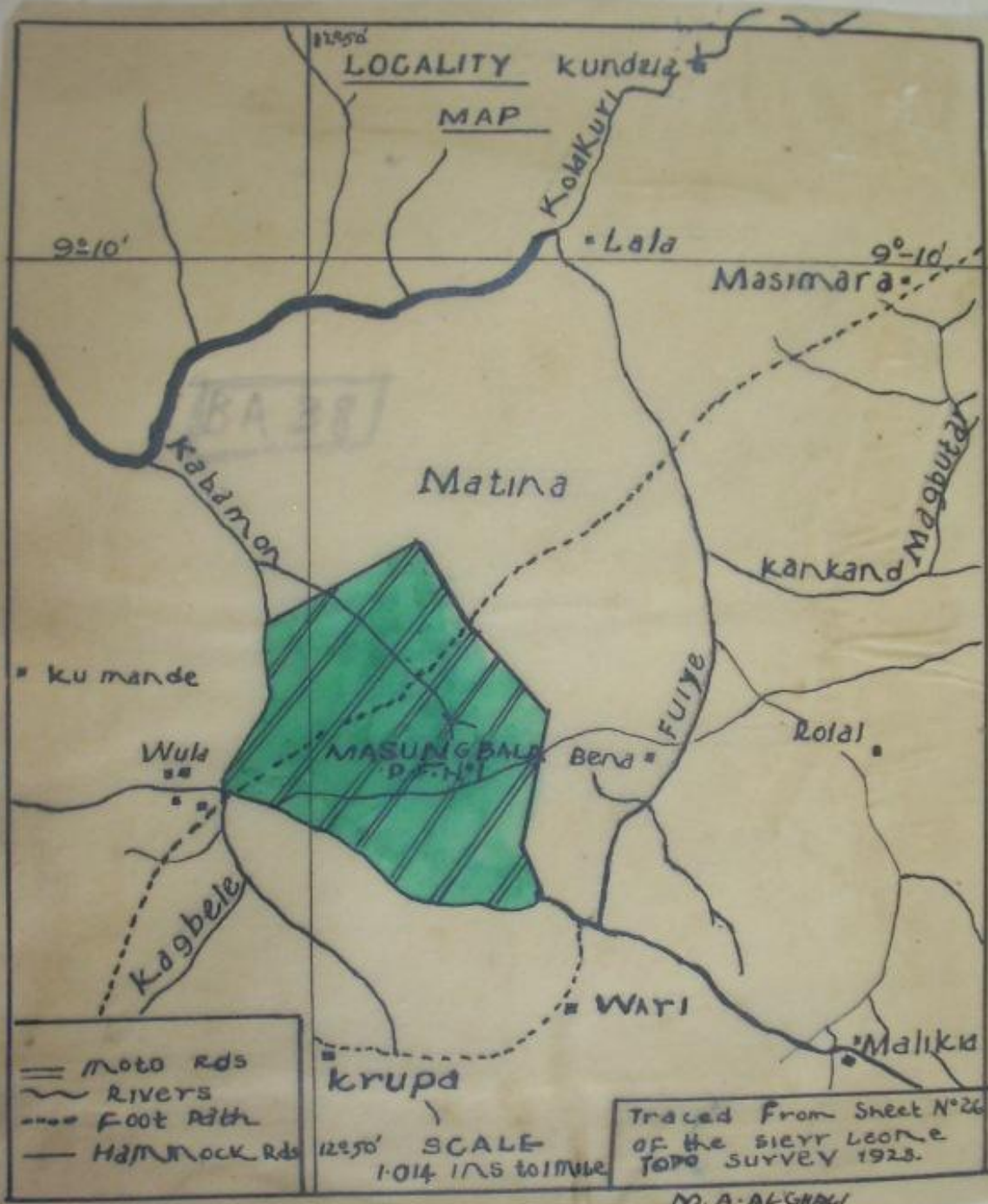

THE FORESTRY ORDINANCE  
(Cap. 36)

THE FORESTRY (MASUNGHALA PROTECTED FOREST No. 1)  
ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1954

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Paramount Chief and Tribal Authority of the Masunghala Chieftdom, Kambia District, Northern Province:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Masunghala Protected Forest No. 1) Order in Council, 1954.
2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT PIECE OF LAND, comprising 180 acres or thereabouts, situated in the Masunghala Chieftdom in the Kambia District of the Northern Province of the Protectorate of Sierra Leone and bounded as follows:—

WEST—

Starting from Boundary Mark No. 1 which is a stone cairn situated on the northern side of the hammock trail from Kawula to Milligia at the point where the said road crosses the Kamabor river; thence by the right bank of the said river downstream in a northerly direction to Boundary Mark No. 2 which is distant about 65.60 chains, measured in a straight line, from Boundary Mark No. 1; thence

NORTH—

by a demarcated line cut on a bearing of approximately  $84^{\circ}45'$  for a distance of about 55.69 chains to Boundary Mark No. 3; thence

EAST—

by a demarcated line cut on a bearing of approximately  $173^{\circ}15'$  for a distance of about 36.91 chains to Boundary Mark No. 4; thence by a demarcated line cut on a bearing of approximately  $145^{\circ}00'$  for a distance of about 7.82 chains to Boundary Mark No. 5; thence by a demarcated line cut on a bearing of approximately  $124^{\circ}30'$  for a distance of about 4.85 chains to Boundary Mark No. 6; thence by a demarcated line cut on a bearing of approximately  $141^{\circ}30'$  for a distance of about 11.48 chains to Boundary Mark No. 7; thence by a demarcated line cut on a bearing of approximately  $178^{\circ}00'$  for a distance of about 16.12 chains to Boundary Mark No. 8; thence by a demarcated line cut on a bearing of approximately  $214^{\circ}30'$  for a distance of about 43.78 chains to Boundary Mark No. 9; thence by a demarcated line cut on a bearing of approximately  $176^{\circ}30'$  for a distance of about 22.86 chains to Boundary Mark No. 10, which is the northern side of the hammock trail from Kawula to Milligia; thence

SOUTH—

by the northern side of the said hammock trail for a distance of about 126.17 chains in a north-westerly direction to Boundary Mark No. 1 which is the starting point.

As the same is more particularly delineated on Plan No. Ba. 1/51 in the office of the Divisional Forest Officer, Barkama, and is shown thereon verged GREEN.

NOTE:—

- (i) All Bearings given above are magnetic bearings taken in the year 1951.
- (ii) All distances given above are in Gunter's chains of 66 feet.
- (iii) All Boundary Marks mentioned above are stone cairns.
- (iv) Demarcated lines mentioned above are cleared traces marked at salient points by stone cairns.
