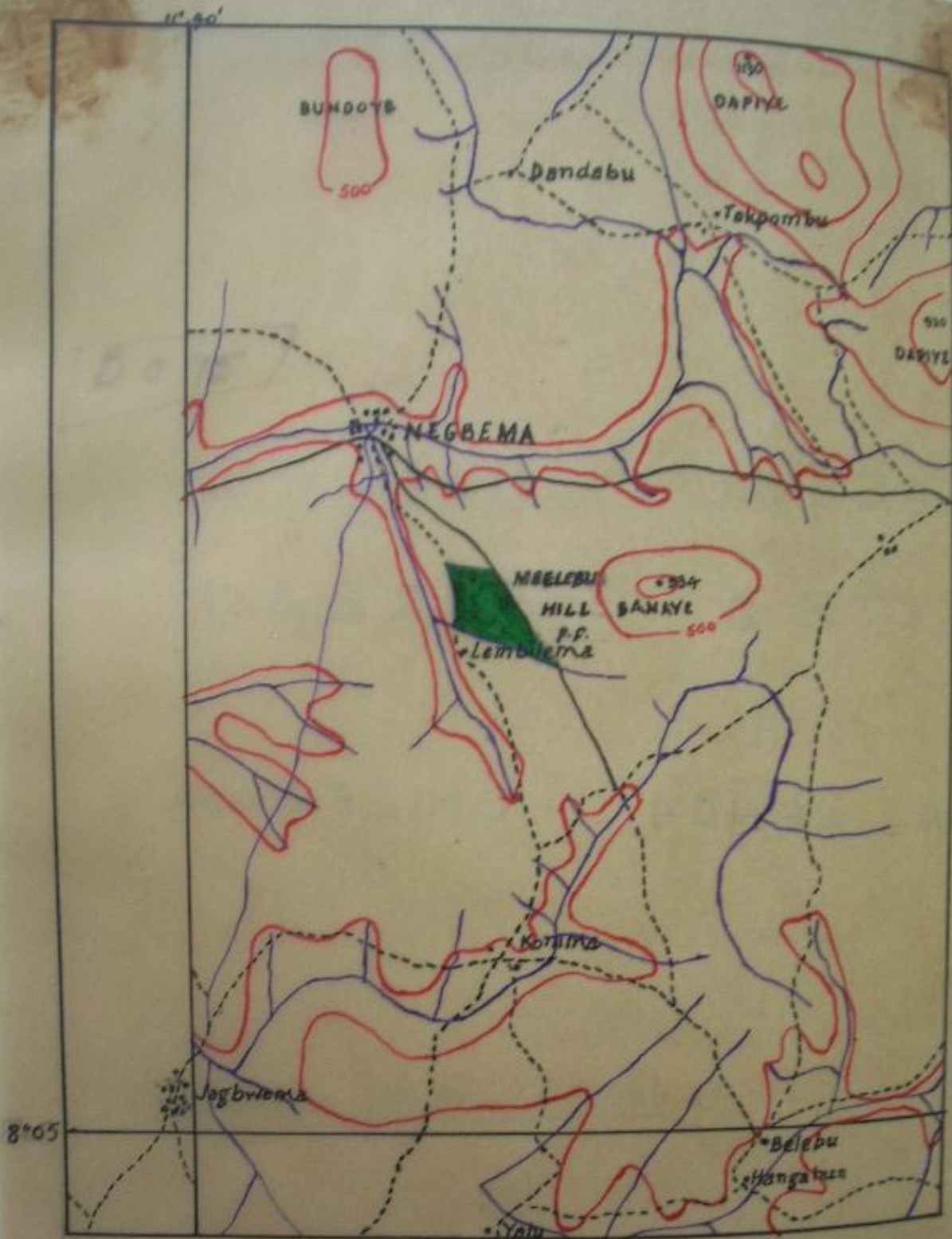

The Forestry Ordinance, 1924.

The Forestry (Ibelebu Hill Protected Forest) Order
in Council, 1946.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, 1924, the following order is hereby made at the request of the Paramount Chief and Tribal Authority of the Ntana Lengwa South Chieftain:-

1. This order may be cited as the Forestry (Ibelebu Hill Protected Forest) Order in Council, 1946.
2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance, 1924.

SCHEDULE.

All that land enclosed within the following boundaries:-

Starting at Boundary Stone No. 1 which is situated on the path between Nengbema and Ibelebu about 1 mile to the south east of Nengbema and proceeding along this path for 1,313 yards to Boundary Stone No. 2 which is at the point where a small unnamed stream crosses the path; thence down this stream for 1,350 yards to Boundary Stone No. 3 which is at the point where this stream crosses the Nengbema-Kenema path; thence up this path towards Nengbema for a distance of 660 yards to Boundary Stone No. 4; thence on a magnetic bearing of 100 degrees for a distance of 530 yards to Boundary Stone No. 1 which is the starting point. Land within these areas occupied by existing houses and compounds, sacred bush and swamps shall be excluded.
