THE FORESTRY ORDINANCE, 1924
(Cap. 74)

THE FORESTRY (NIMI KORO PROTECTED FOREST) ORDER
IN COUNCIL, 1946

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, 1924, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Paramount Chief and Tribal Authority of the Nimi Koro Chiefdom:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Nimi Koro Protected Forest) Order in Council, 1946.

2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forest Ordinance, 1924.

SCHEDULE

ALL THOSE PLOTS OF LAND 330 feet wide which lie on either side of the centre line of each of the following roads in so far as they lie within the Nimi Koro Chiefdom:—

Jaima to Sefadu
Yengema to Shongbo
Shongo to Bagbwema

but excluding all land occupied by houses and compounds at the date of this Order.
