**THE FORESTRY (PANGA-KABONDE NATIVE ADMINISTRATION
PROTECTED FOREST NO. 1) ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1952**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Paramount Chief and members of the Tribal Authority of the Panga-Kabonde Chieftdom, Pujehun District, South-western Province.

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Panga-Kabonde Native Administration Protected Forest No. 1) Order in Council, 1952.
2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT LAND comprising 165 acres or thereabouts lying within 210 feet on either side of the centre of the road from Groundapi to Pujehun in the Panga-Kabonde Chieftdom in the Pujehun District of the South-western Province of Sierra Leone, commencing at a point on the said road distant about 4,920 feet in a north-easterly direction from milestone 59 and ending about 591 feet North-west of milestone 49. Provided that the following areas shall be excluded from the Protected Forest now constituted:—

Between points distant about 4,117 feet and 9,564 feet from the starting point, which includes Najai village.

Between points distant about 13,856 feet and 14,441 feet from the starting point on the southern side of the road and 14,169 feet and 14,397 feet on the northern side of the road, which includes a swamp.

Between points distant about 16,370 feet and 16,763 feet from the starting point, which includes a swamp.

Between points distant about 19,858 feet and 31,845 feet from the starting point, which includes Gibina and Yikadaw villages.
