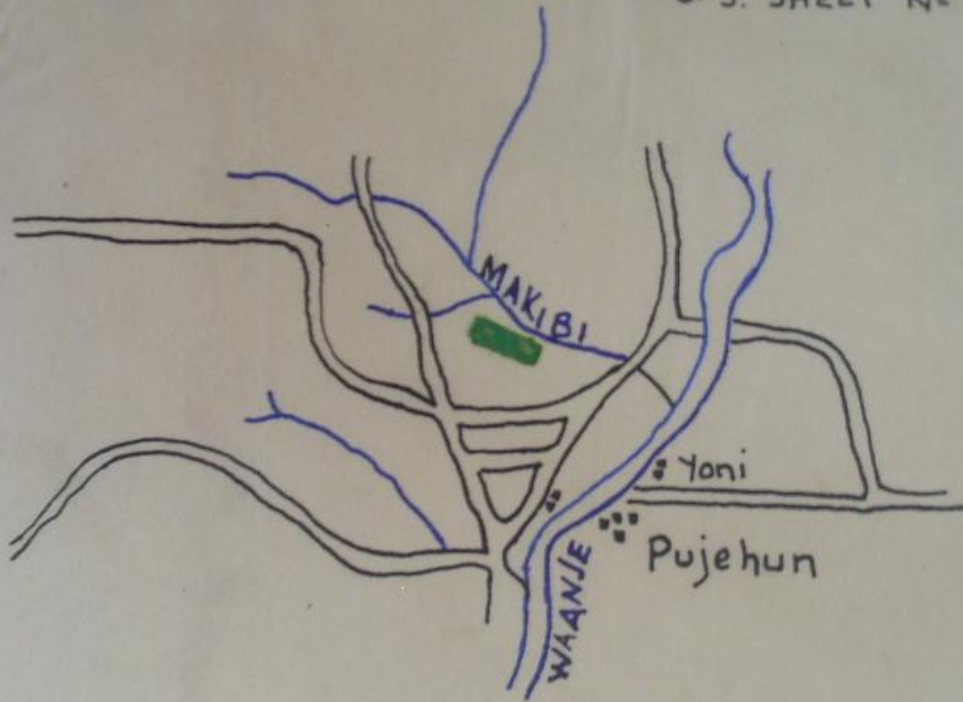

THE FORESTRY ORDINANCE
(Cap. 86)

THE FORESTRY (PANGA-KABONDE NATIVE ADMINISTRATION
PROTECTED FOREST NO. 3) ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1952

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Paramount Chief and members of the Tribal Authority of the Panga-Kabonde Chiefdom, Pujehun District, South-western Province.

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Panga-Kabonde Native Administration Protected Forest No. 3) Order in Council, 1952.

2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT PIECE OF LAND comprising 36 acres or thereabouts, situated in the Panga-Kabonde Chiefdom in the Pujehun District of the South-western Province of Sierra Leone and bounded as follows:—

Starting from Boundary Mark No. 1 which is situated on the North-western side of the footpath running from the Bundapi to Pujehun road to the site of the projected pump house on the bank of the Makibi River at a point distant about 1,994 feet in a North-easterly direction from the junction of the said footpath with the said road; thence

WEST—

by a demarcated line out on a bearing of approximately 307 degrees for a distant of about 2,406 feet to Boundary Mark No. 2; thence

NORTH—

by a demarcated line cut on a bearing of approximately 40 degrees for a distance of about 668 feet to Boundary Mark No. 2; thence

EAST—

by a demarcated line cut on a bearing of approximately 127 degrees for a distance of about 2,406 feet to Boundary Mark No. 4; thence
