THE FORESTRY ORDINANCE
(Cap. 86)

THE FORESTRY (SAFROKO TEMNE PROTECTED FOREST No. 1)
ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1953

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Tribal Authority of the Safroko Temne Chiefdom, Port Loko District, Northern Province:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Safroko Temne Protected Forest No. 1) Order in Council, 1953.

2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT PIECE OF LAND, comprising 27 acres or thereabouts, situated in the Safroko Temne Chiefdom in the Port Loko District of the Northern Province of the Protectorate of Sierra Leone and bounded as follows:—

WEST—

Starting from Boundary Mark No. 1, which is a point situated on the eastern side of the hammock trail from Maron to Petifu at a distance of about 16.34 chains along the said hammock trail in a northerly direction from the centre of the crossroads in Maron; thence by the eastern side of the said hammock trail for a distance of about 13.08 chains in a northerly direction to Boundary Mark No. 2 thence

NORTH—

by a demarcated line cut on a bearing of approximately $81^{\circ}45'$ for a distance of about 2.66 chains
