**SAMU No. 2.**

1. This Order may be cited as the Samu No. 2 Protected Forest Order.

2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a protected forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

**SCHEDULE.**

All that piece of land in the Samu Chieftdom in the Kambia District which lies within 330 feet of either side of the centre of the hammock path from Kasiri to Bokaria commencing at approximately 5.6 chains from the outskirts of Kasiri and ending at the outskirts of Bokaria with the exception of the portions listed below—

1. The piece of land lying between a distance of 28.9 chains and a distance of 63.64 chains from the starting point containing One House Village.

2. The piece of land lying between a distance of 130.31 chains and a distance of 137.89 chains from the starting point containing Matety Village.

3. The piece of land lying between a distance of 165.16 chains and a distance of 187.89 chains from the starting point containing Madina Village.

All measurements are in Gunter's chains of 66 feet.
