SAMU No. 3.

1. This Order may be cited as the Samu No. 3 Protected Forest Order.

2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a protected forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

SCHEDULE.

All that piece of land in the Samu Chiefdom in the Kambia District, within 330 feet of the centre of the hammock path from Yamakabaia to Main Road Junction Village, commencing at a point approximately 27-76 chains from the outskirts of Yamakabaia and ending at the outskirts of Main Road Junction Village, with the exception of those portions listed below—

1. The piece of land lying between a distance of 109-1 chains and a distance of 110-1 chains from the starting point containing Makaboh Village.
2. The piece of land lying between a distance of 180-3 chains and a distance of 185-2 chains from the starting point containing Goro-konpa Village.

All measurements are in Gunter's chains of 66 feet.
