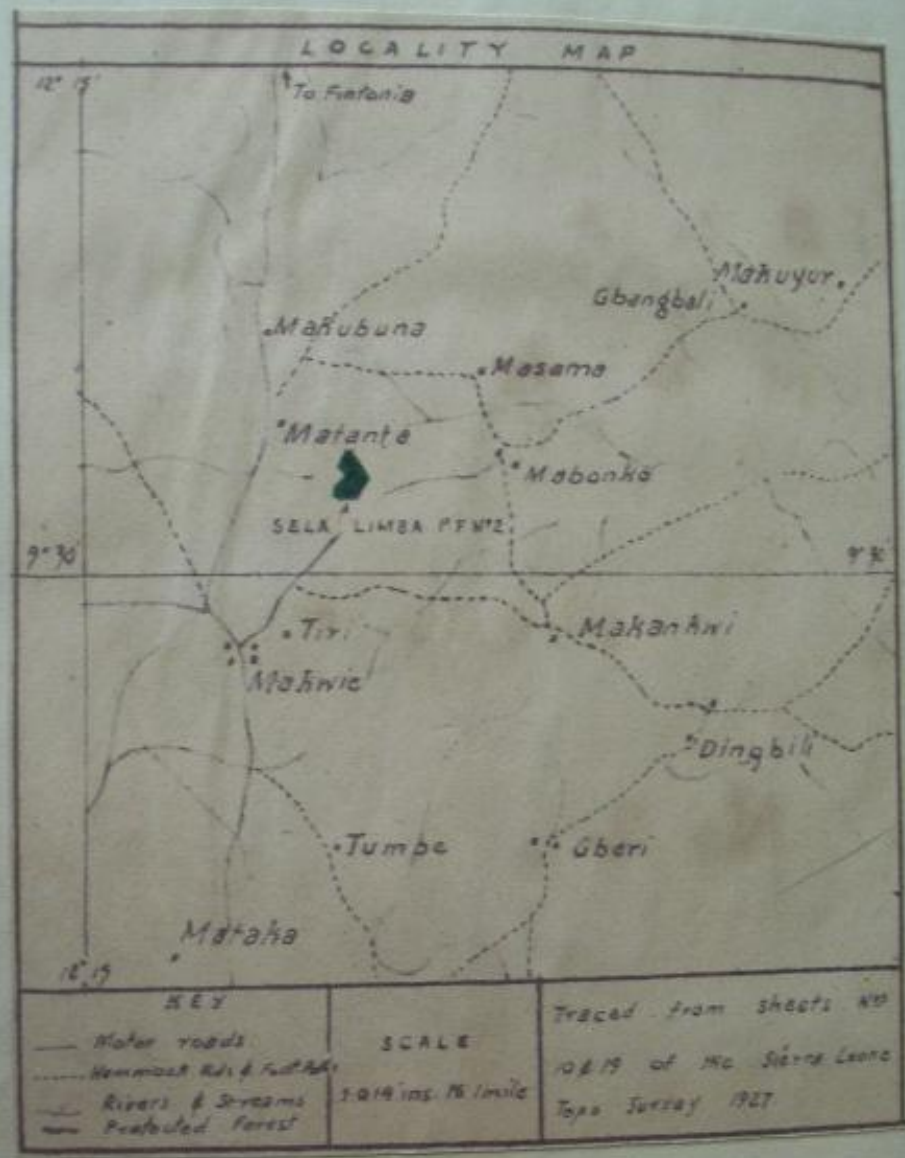

THE FORESTRY ORDINANCE
(Cap. 86)

THE FORESTRY (SELA LIMBA PROTECTED FOREST No. 2)
ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1956

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Tribal Authority of the Sela Limba Chiefdom, Bombali District, Northern Province:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Sela Limba Protected Forest No. 2) Order in Council, 1956.
2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT PIECE OR PARCEL OF LAND comprising 17 acres or thereabouts, situated in the Sela Limba Chiefdom in the Bombali District of the Northern Province of the Protectorate of Sierra Leone and bounded as follows:—

Starting from boundary stone No. 1 which is a stone cairn situated on the North-eastern edge of the Matea Swamp, and distant 28.00 chains measured in a straight line on a bearing of 99½ degrees from the centre of the bridge over the said swamp on the Kamakwie to Katanta motor road; thence by a series of cut and beacons lines as follows—

Boundary Stone No. 7 is situated on the South-eastern side of the Matea swamp; thence in a northerly direction along the eastern edge of the said swamp to Boundary Stone No. 1, which is distant 12.10 chains measured in a straight line on a bearing of 012 degrees from Boundary Stone No. 7.

As the Protected Forest is illustrated and the boundary of the swamp more particularly delineated on Forest Department Plan No. BA. 66 and is shown thereon verged GREEN.

- (1) All bearings given above are approximate magnetic bearings taken in the year 1954.
- (2) All distances given above are approximate in Gunter's chain of 66 feet.
- (3) All Boundary Stone described above are stone cairns.
