THE FORESTRY ORDINANCE  
(Cap. 86)

THE FORESTRY (SIMBARU PROTECTED FOREST No. 3)  
ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1954

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Paramount Chief and Tribal Authority of the Simbaru Chiefdom, Kenema District, South-eastern Province:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Simbaru Protected Forest No. 3) Order in Council, 1954.
2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT LAND, comprising 572 acres or thereabouts, in the Simbaru Chiefdom in the Kenema District of the South-eastern Province of the Protectorate of Sierra Leone, bounded by a cleared trace and lying within 5 chains on either side of the centre of the hammock path from Boajibu to Dodo starting at a point about 26.7 chains from the junction of the said hammock path with the Boajibu-Blama motor road and ending at a point on the boundary between Simbaru and Dodo Chiefdoms, provided that the following areas within 5 chains from and on either side of the centre of the hammock path shall be excluded:—

1. that area, which includes a swamp between points distant about 25 chains and about 32.2 chains from the starting point, measured along the hammock path;
2. that area, which includes a deserted village, between points distant about 90.4 chains and about 93 chains from the starting point, measured along the hammock path;
3. that area, which includes Bunjema Town, between points distant about 175.4 chains and about 216.8 chains from the starting point, measured along the hammock path;
4. that area, which includes Lomabu Village, between points distant about 405 chains and about 433.3 chains from the starting point, measured along the hammock path;

5. that area, which includes Goma Village, between points distant about 502.3 chains and about 551.2 chains from the starting point, measured along the hammock path; and,
6. that area, which includes a Kola plantation, between points distant about 567.2 chains and about 572.8 chains from the starting point, measured along the hammock path.

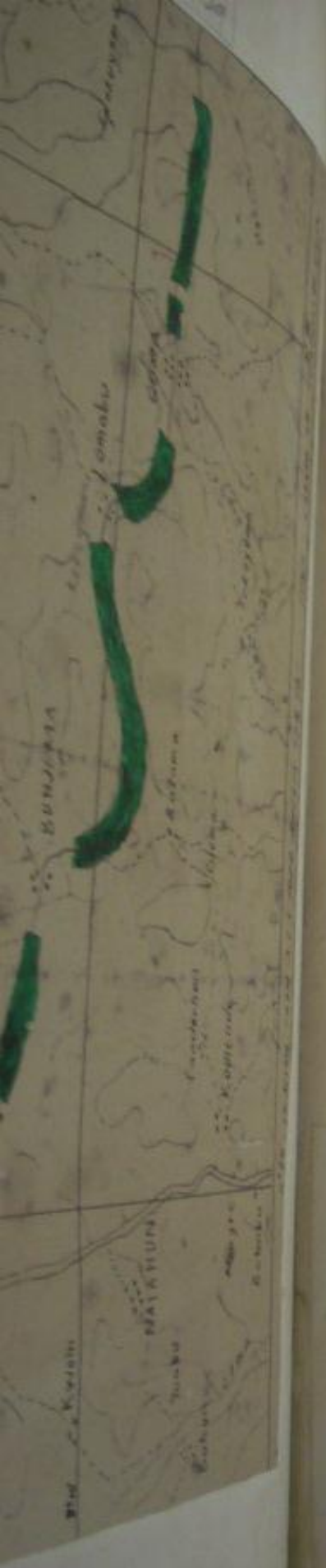
As the same is more particularly delineated on Plan K 129 of the Forestry Department and shown thereon verged GREEN.

NOTE—

All distances are in chains of 66 feet.
