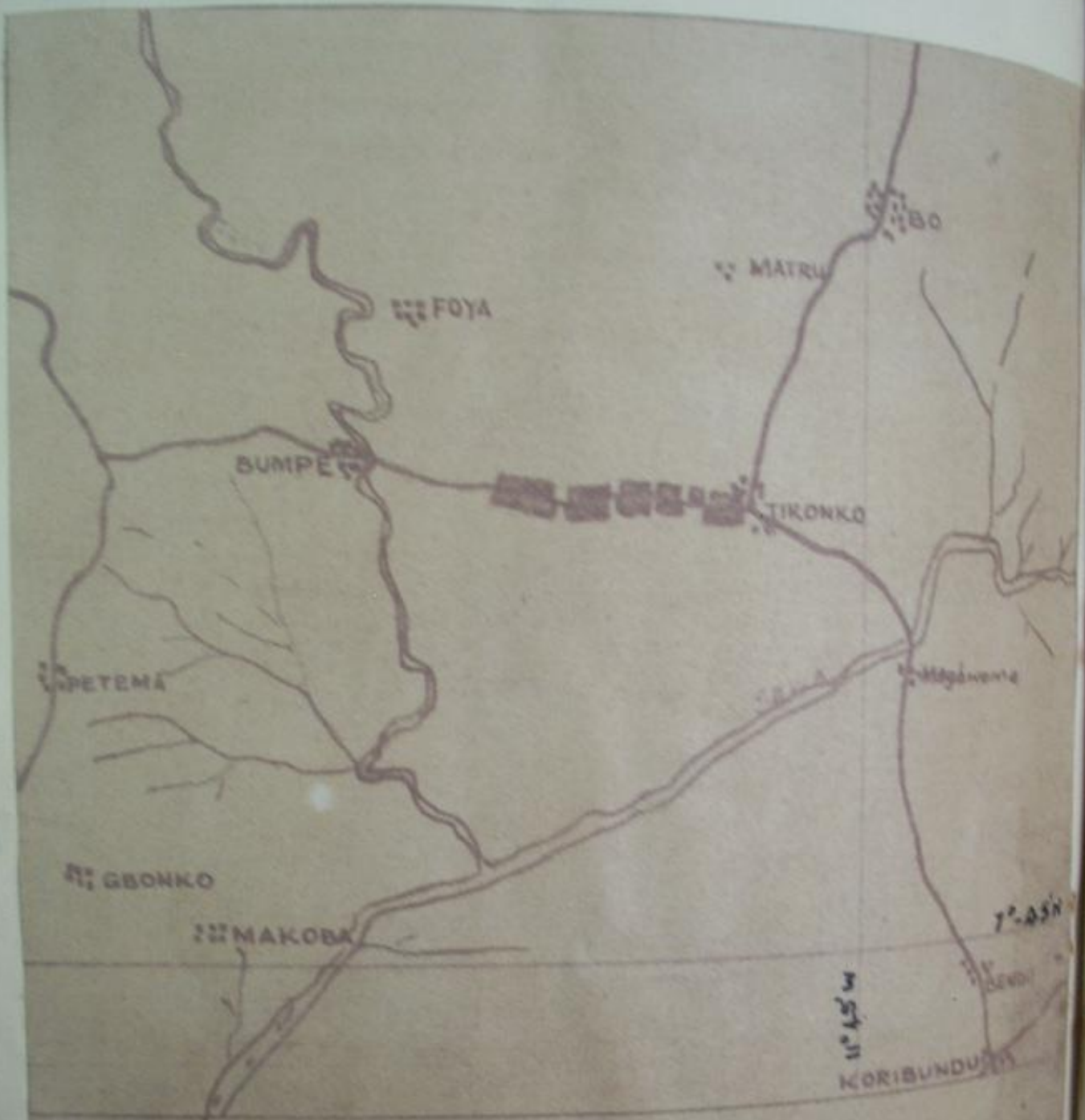

THE FORESTRY ORDINANCE (Cap. 86)

THE FORESTRY (TIKONKO PROTECTED FOREST No. 2) ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1954

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Tribal Authority of the Tikonko Chiefdom, Bo District, South-western Province:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Tikonko Protected Forest No. 2) Order in Council, 1954.

2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

3. The Forestry (Tikonko Protected Forest No. 2) Order in Council, 1946, is hereby revoked. Supp. Vol. II, Page 229.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT LAND comprising 223.29 acres or thereabouts, bounded by a cleared trace and lying within 210 feet on either side of the centre of the motor road from Bo to Bumpé in the Tikonko Chiefdom in the Bo District of the South-western Province of the Protectorate of Sierra Leone, starting at a point about 2,088 feet South from Milestone 6 which is the Tikonko Junction, thence West-wards and ending at a point about 2,650 feet beyond Milestone 11 which is the boundary of the Bumpé Chiefdom, provided that the following areas shall be excluded from the Protected Forest:—

Between points distant about 0 feet and 210 feet from the starting point which includes Tikonko Protected Forest No. 1;

Between points distant 2,520 feet and 3,263 feet North from Milestone 7, measured in the direction of Milestone 8, which includes Salobu Village;

Between points distant about 4,714 feet and 4,955 feet on the Northern side of the road and 4,780 feet and 5,020 feet on the Southern side of the road from Milestone 7, measured in the direction of Milestone 8, which includes the Kasawa Swamp;

Between points distant about 2,790 feet and 4,400 feet on the Northern side of the road and 2,790 feet and 4,360 feet on the Southern side of the road from Milestone 8, measured in the direction of Milestone 9, which includes a Sacred Bush and Laimblema Village;

Between points distant about 4,290 feet and 4,430 feet on the Northern side of the road and 3,720 feet and 4,917 feet on the Southern side of the road from Milestone 9, measured in the direction of Milestone 10, which includes a Sacred Bush and Korgbotu Swamp;

Between points distant about 34 feet and 495 feet on the Northern side of the road and 34 feet and 330 feet on the Southern side of the road from Milestone 10, measured in the direction of Milestone 11, which includes the Baingi Swamp;

Between points distant about 2,580 feet and 2,650 feet from Milestone 11, measured in the direction of Milestone 12, which includes the Geanigiema Swamp;

The same is illustrated on Plan No. BO 121 in the office of the Chief Conservator of Forests, New England, and in the Divisional Forest Office, Bo, and shown thereon marked GREEN.
