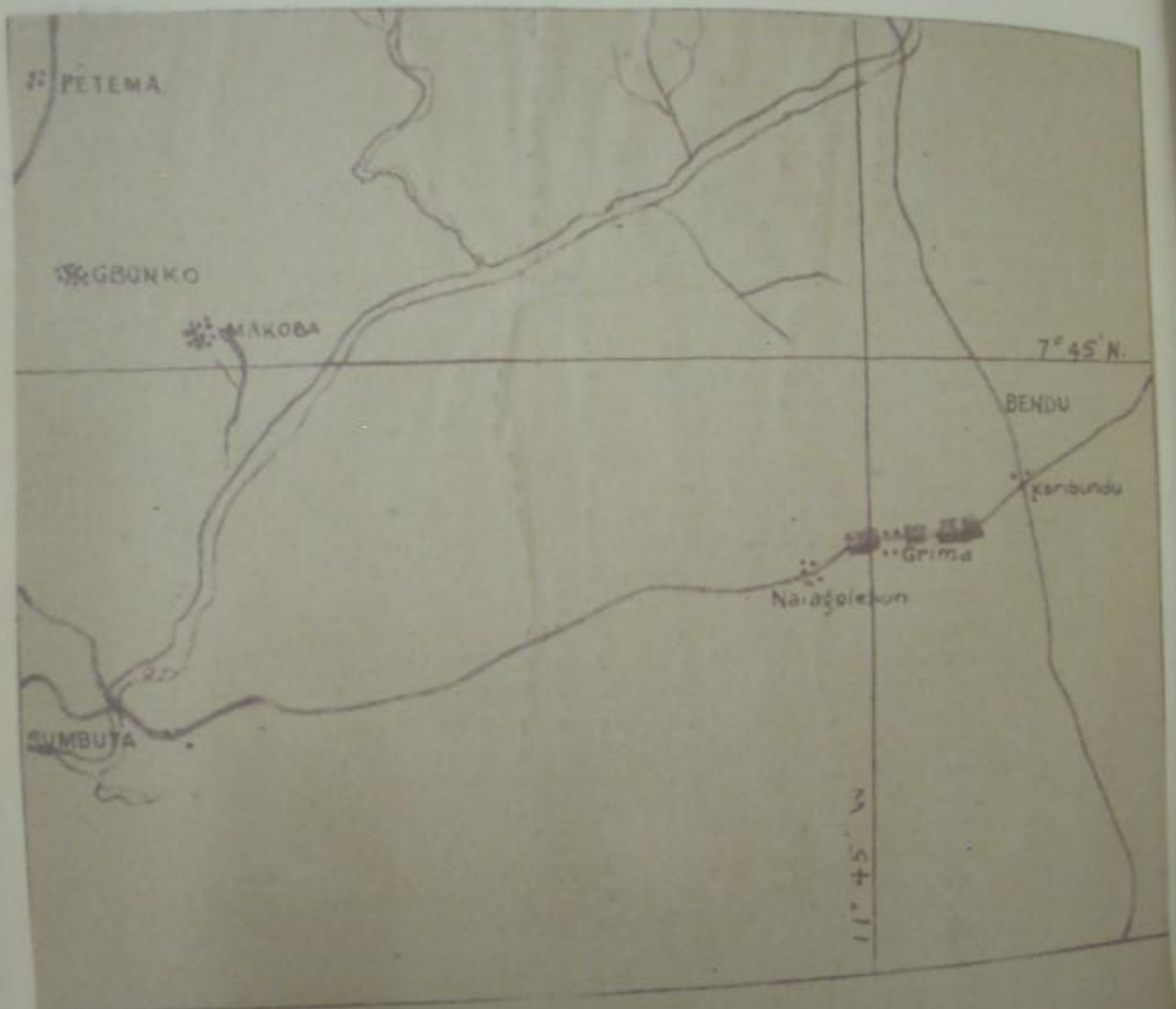

THE FORESTRY ORDINANCE
(Cap. 86)

THE FORESTRY (TIKONKO PROTECTED FOREST No. 3)
ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1954

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Tribal Authority of the Tikonko Chiefdom, Bo District, South-western Province:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Tikonko Protected Forest No. 3) Order in Council, 1954.

2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

3. The Forestry (Tikonko Protected Forest No. 3) Order in Council, 1946, is hereby revoked. Supp. Vol. II,
Page 229.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT LAND comprising 90.65 acres or thereabouts, bounded by a cleared trace and lying within 210 feet on either side of the motor road from Sumbuya to Koribundu in the Tikonko Chiefdom in the Bo District of the South-western Province of the Protectorate of Sierra Leone, starting at a point about 1,070 feet East from Milestone 16, which is the boundary of the Jimmi Gbagbo Chiefdom and ending at a point 3,790 feet beyond Milestone 18, provided that the following areas shall be excluded from the Protected Forest:—

Between points distant about 4,115 feet and 7,238 feet from the starting point which includes the Teigbe Swamp, Public Works Department shimbecks, and Grima Village.

Between points distant about 573 feet and 990 feet on the Southern side of the road and 573 feet and 1,140 feet on the Northern side of the road from Milestone 18, measured in the direction of Milestone 19, which includes the Playie Swamp.

Between points distant about 2,200 feet and 2,600 feet on the Northern side of the road from Milestone 18, measured in the direction of Milestone 19, which includes a coffee plantation.

The same is illustrated on Plan No. BO 122 in the office of the Chief Conservator of Forests, New England and in the Divisional Forest Office, Bo, and shown thereon marked GREEN.
