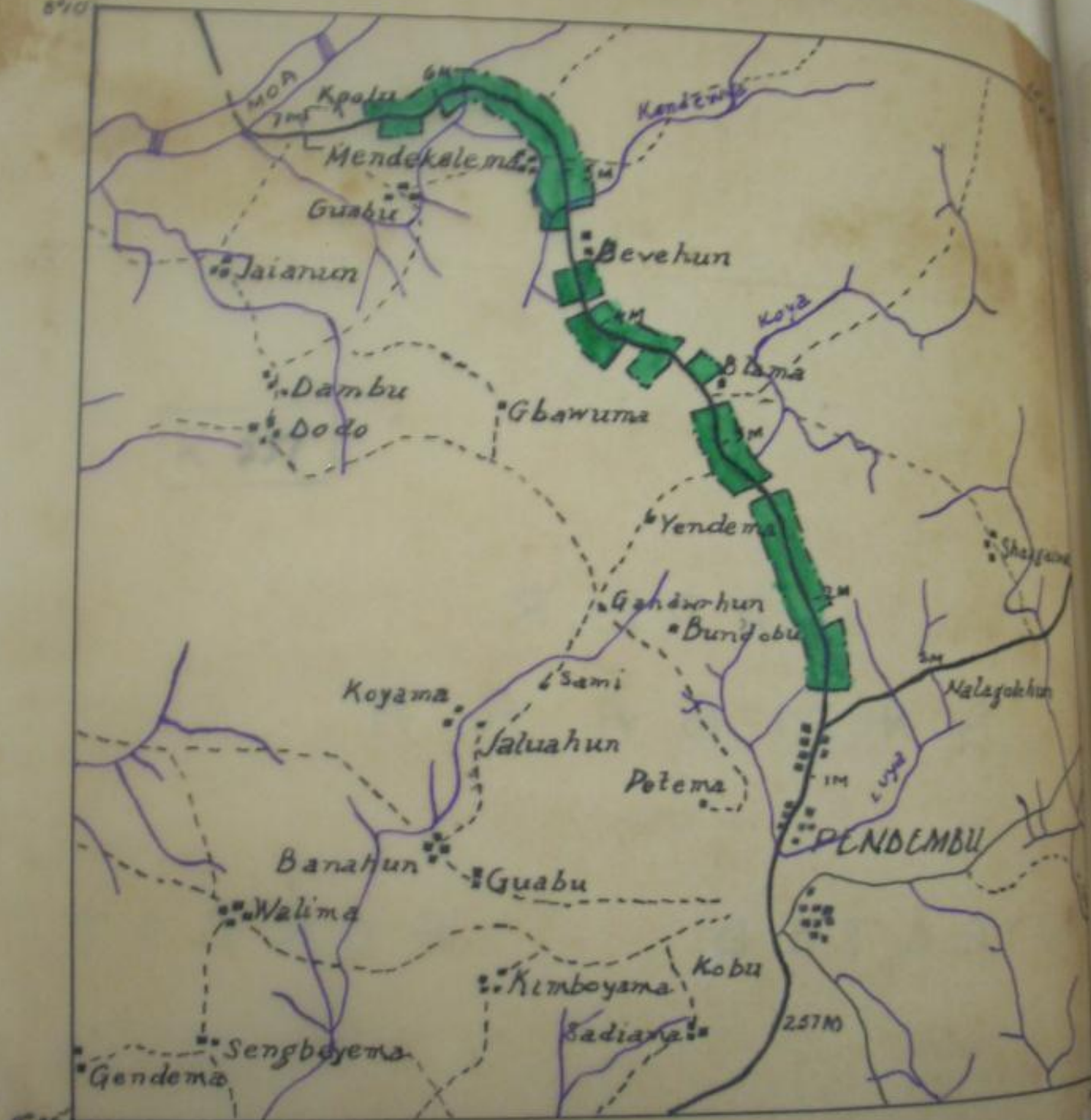

*THE FORESTRY ORDINANCE, 1924*  
(Cap. 74)

*THE FORESTRY (UPPER BAMBARA PROTECTED FOREST No. 2)*  
*ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1945*

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, 1924, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Paramount Chief and Tribal Authority of the Upper Bambara Chiefdom:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Upper Bambara Protected Forest No. 2) Order in Council, 1945.
2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance, 1924.

SCHEDULE

ALL THOSE TWO PLOTS OR STRIPS OF LAND lying on either side of the Pendembu-Manowa Motor Road between the Moa ferry and the junction of the said road with the Pendembu-Kailahun Road to a depth of 330 feet on either side from the centre line of the said Pendembu-Manowa Motor Road, excluding all land occupied by houses and compounds at the date of this Order.
