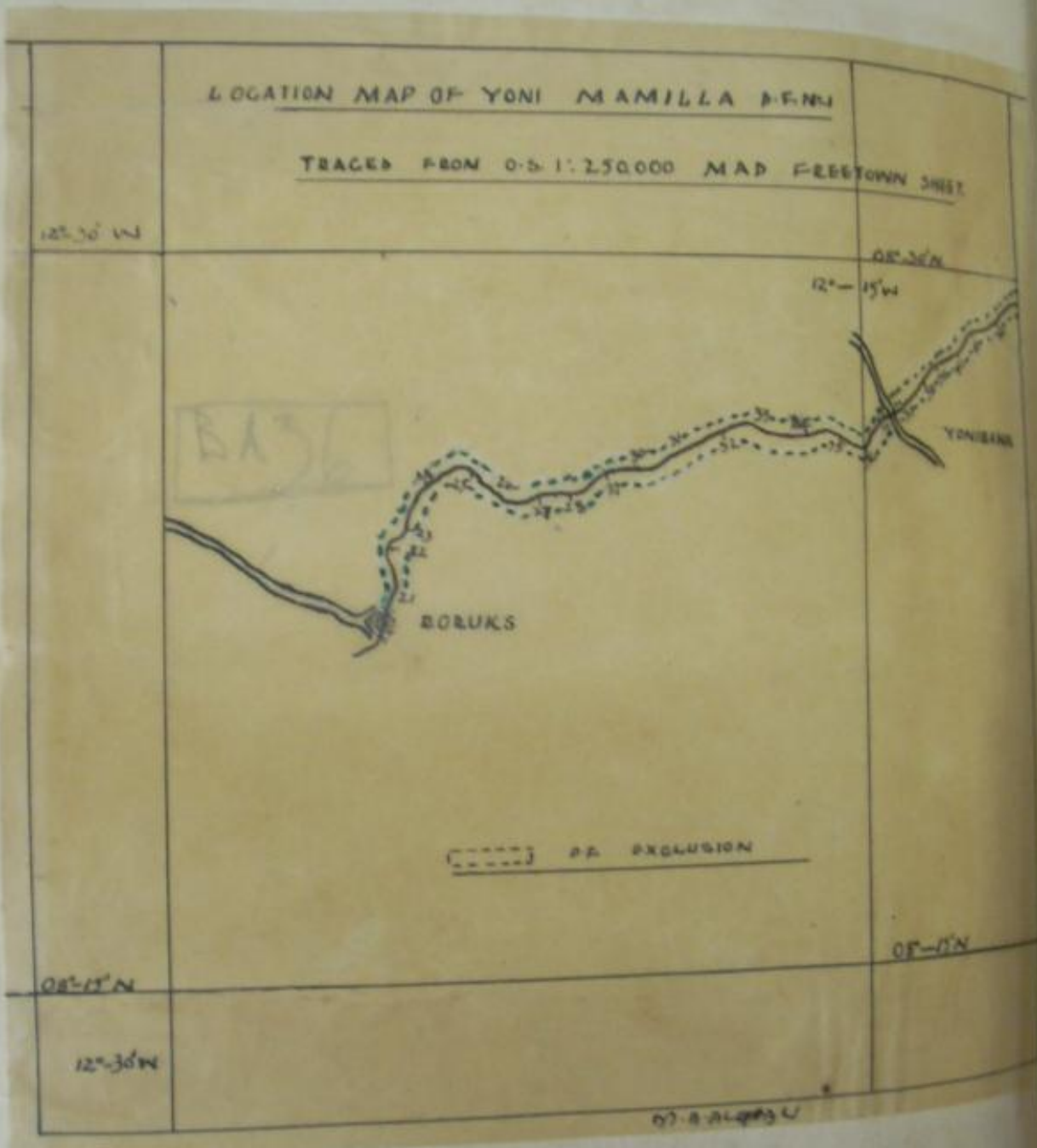

THE FORESTRY (YONI NATIVE ADMINISTRATION PROTECTED
FOREST No. 1) ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1951

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Paramount Chief and Tribal Authority of the Yoni Chieftom, Tonkolili District, Northern Province.

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Yoni Native Administration Protected Forest No. 1) Order in Council, 1951.

2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT LAND comprising 583 acres or thereabout, bounded by a cleared trace and lying within 210 feet on either side of the centre of the railway line from Bauya to Makeni in the Yoni Chieftom in the Tonkolili District of the Northern Province of the Protectorate of Sierra Leone, starting at a point about 983 feet north of Railway milestone 21/ii and ending at a point about 150 feet north-east of Railway milestone 43/ii, provided that the following areas shall be excluded from the Protected Forest:—

Between points about 618 feet and 1,720 feet distant from the starting point which includes Small Mafugbu Village.

Between points about 9,565 feet and 11,989 feet distant from the starting point which includes Makonkari Village.

Between points about 13,166 feet and 13,441 feet distant from the starting point which includes a Railway Compound.

SCHEDULE—*continued*

Between points about 13,766 feet and 13,786 feet distant from the starting point which includes a swamp.

Between points about 16,072 feet and 17,377 feet distant from the starting point which includes Magbant Village.

Between points about 18,705 feet and 21,948 feet distant from the starting point which includes a swamp.

Between points about 22,568 feet and 24,398 feet distant from the starting point which includes a swamp.

Between points about 26,738 feet and 27,043 feet distant from the starting point which includes a swamp.

Between points about 27,755 feet and 28,772 feet distant from the starting point which includes a swamp.

Between points about 29,687 feet and 31,110 feet distant from the starting point which includes a swamp.

Between points about 32,940 feet and 37,108 feet distant from the starting point which includes Makrogba Village.

Between points about 39,453 feet and 39,657 feet distant from the starting point which includes a swamp.

Between points about 41,582 feet and 41,785 feet distant from the starting point which includes a swamp.

Between points about 42,497 feet and 42,751 feet distant from the starting point which includes a swamp.

Between points about 43,364 feet and 43,918 feet distant from the starting point which includes a Railway Compound.

Between points about 44,327 feet and 44,937 feet distant from the starting point which includes a swamp.

Between points about 48,910 feet and 52,663 feet distant from the starting point which includes Kumrabai Village.

Between points about 60,288 feet and 61,805 feet distant from the starting point which includes Masengbe Village.

Between points about 65,067 feet and 65,372 feet distant from the starting point which includes a Railway Compound.

Between points about 69,955 feet and 71,159 feet distant from the starting point which includes Makagbo Village.

Between points about 75,445 feet and 76,750 feet distant from the starting point which includes Rolath Village.

Between points about 77,588 feet and 83,883 feet distant from the starting point which includes the town of Yonibana.

Between points about 85,491 feet and 88,043 feet distant from the starting point which includes Makori Village.

Between points about 93,533 feet and 93,838 feet distant from the starting point which includes Kasewe Siding.

Between points about 96,889 feet and 98,363 feet distant from the starting point which includes Masuri Village.

Between points about 104,463 feet and 105,022 feet distant from the starting point which includes a swamp.

Between points about 105,823 feet and 107,532 feet distant from the starting point which includes Togbambu Village.

Between points about 109,809 feet and 111,419 feet distant from the starting point which includes Kendima Village.

Between points about 112,138 feet and 113,155 feet distant from the starting point which includes a swamp.

Between points about 113,562 feet and 113,867 feet distant from the starting point which includes a Railway Compound.

And all that land lying within 33 feet on either side of the centre of the railway, which is railway property.

As the same is more particularly delineated on Plan No. Bo 8/50 in the office of the Divisional Forest Officer, Bo, and shown thereon verged GREEN.
