THE FORESTRY (GORI HILLS) FOREST RESERVE)

ORDER-IN-COUNCIL 1935

ORDER

This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Forest Reserve) (Gori Hills) Order.

2. The lands hereinafter described shall be a forest reserve, namely:-

The lands lying in the Fiama, Gbane, Penguia and Soa Chiefdoms of the Kono District and in the Yawei Chiefdom of the Kailahun District of the South-Eastern Province of the Protectorate, known as the Gori Hills Forest and covering an area of 21,165 acres more or less, which are marked out and beacons with two hundred and twenty-four cairns of stones.

3. The natives of the Fiama, Gbane, Penguia and Soa Chiefdoms of the Kono District and of the Yawei Chiefdom of the Kailahun District of the South-Eastern Province of the Protectorate shall be entitled at all times to enter the forest reserve without fee, let or hindrance, for the purposes of passing through the forest reserve, hunting and trapping animals, fishing, and collecting palm wine, palm products, rattans, thatch, kola nuts and honey.
