THE FORESTRY (KASEWE HILLS FOREST RESERVE

ORDER-IN-COUNCIL 1914

ORDER

This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Forest Reserve) (Kasewe Hills) Order.

2. The lands specified in the schedule hereto shall be constituted a Forest Reserve.

3. The Mendi people having kila trees in the said Forest Reserve shall be entitled at all times without fee, let or hindrance to enter upon the said Forest Reserve for the purpose of picking the fruit of the kola trees growing thereon as well as to gather pepper.

THE SCHEDULE

Starting from boundary stone No. 1, which is situated some 300 yards south of the summit of the most northerly hill of the range known as the Kasewe Hills, in a north-easterly direction to boundary stone No. 2, which is situated on the shoulder of the hill; thence in a south-easterly direction to boundary stone No. 4, which is situated on the highest peak of the range; thence in a south-easterly direction to boundary stone No. 5, which is situated on the main ridge of the southernmost portion of the range; thence in a south-westerly direction to boundary stone No. 6, which is situated on the top of the south spur of the range above Faroma; thence in a south-westerly direction to boundary stone No. 7, which is situated in the south corner of the grass field to the north of Bunguma; thence in a north-westerly direction to boundary stone No. 8, which is situated to the right of the path leading from Faroma to Moyamba-Wuru and at a point some 100 yards beyond where the path emerges from the forest; thence in a north-westerly direction to boundary stone No. 9, which is situated on the edge of the forest, to the south-east of Moyamba-Wuru; thence in a north-westerly direction to boundary stone No.10, which is situated to the north of Moyamba-Wuru to the right of the path leading to Bunkababe and thence in a north-westerly direction to boundary stone No.11, which is situated in marshy ground to the right of the same path; thence in a northerly direction to the boundary stone No.12, which is situated to the left of the same path and to the south of Bunkababe; thence in a north-easterly direction to boundary stone No. 1 above described.
