THE FORESTRY (MOYAMBA HILL) FOREST RESERVE)

ORDER-IN-COUNCIL 1924

ORDER

This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Forest Reserve) (Moyamba Hill) Order.

2. The lands specified in the schedule hereto shall be a Forest Reserve.

3. The natives of the Kaiyamba and the Kongbora Chiefdoms, in the Moyamba District, shall be entitled at all times to enter upon so much of the lands of the Forest Reserve as are in their respective chiefdoms without fee, let or hindrance, for the purpose of taking the fruits of the *Cola acuminata* (kola), *Elaeis guineensis* (oil palm), *Musa paradisiaca* (plantain) *Musa sapientum* (banana), tapping the trees of the species *Raphia vinifera* (bamboo palm) and the taking of palm wine from them, collecting snails, collecting stones on which to sharpen farming implements, hunting and killing any wild animals and reptiles, travelling through the Forest Reserve from one place to another, collecting ginger now growing upon the Forest Reserve so soon as it shall be ripe, and for no other purpose whatever.

THE SCHEDULE

Commencing at boundary stone No. 1 about one mile and a sixth approximately west-south-west of Moyamba Railway Station and proceeding thence for a distance of 1,866 yards on a magnetic bearing of 330 degrees to boundary stone No. 2 on the Moyamba-Yoyema road; thence along the above road a distance of 236 yards on a magnetic bearing of 285 degrees to boundary stone No. 3; thence for a distance of 1,520 yards on a magnetic bearing of 210 degrees to boundary stone No. 4; thence for a distance of 1,006 yards on a magnetic bearing of 150 degrees to boundary stone No. 5; thence for a distance of 1,492 yards on a magnetic bearing of 70 degrees to boundary stone No. 1 described above.
