THE FORESTRY ORDINANCE
(Cap. 86)

THE FORESTRY (FOREST RESERVE) (PORT LOKO) ORDER, 1949

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor by section 4 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Paramount Chief and members of the Tribal Authority of the Bake Loko Chiefdom.

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Forest Reserve) (Port Loko) Order, 1949.

2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Forest Reserve within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

3. The natives of the Bake Loko Chiefdom of the Port Loko District of the Northern Province of the Protectorate shall be entitled at all times to enter the forest reserve without fee, let or hindrance for the following purposes:—

- (a) to pick the fruits of the oil-palm and existing kola trees;
- (b) to hunt capture or kill wild animals, birds fish or reptiles in accordance with the law;
- (c) to travel through the reserve from place to place; and
- (d) to cut and remove thatch grass.

4. The Forestry (Forest Reserve) (Port Loko East) Order, is hereby revoked.
