### THE FORESTRY ORDINANCE (Cap. 86)

#### THE FORESTRY (WARA WAR HILLS FOREST RESERVE) ORDER, 1960

WHEREAS by an Instrument dated 13th day of April, 1956, the Tribal Authority of the Wara Wara Bafodea Chiefdom and the Tribal Authority of the Dembelia Musaia Chiefdom both of the Koinadugu District in the Northern Province of the Protectorate of Sierra Leone have requested that certain native land situate in the Wara Wara Hills in the aforesaid Chiefdoms be constituted a forest reserve:

AND WHEREAS in accordance with the provisions of section 5 of the Forestry Ordinance, Government Notice No. 821 was published in the *Gazette* dated 13th August, 1959—

- (a) specifying the situation and limits of the aforesaid land,
- (b) declaring the intention to constitute the aforesaid land a forest reserve for the particular use and benefit of the native community within the Protectorate, within the limits of whose occupation the reserve is situated, and
- (c) appointing the Commissioner of the Northern Province as the Reserve Settlement Commissioner to hold an enquiry regarding the land aforesaid:

AND WHEREAS in accordance with sections 6, 7 and 9 of the aforesaid Ordinance, the Reserve Settlement Commissioner duly gave notice of, and conducted, the enquiry with the assistance of the Paramount Chiefs of Wara Wara Bafodea and Dembelia Musaia Chiefdoms within whose jurisdictions the Wara Wara Hills (Proposed) Forest Reserve lies and by the Paramount Chiefs of Wara Wara Yagala and Kasunko Chiefdoms, and delivered his judgement on the 20th day of April, 1960:

AND WHEREAS no appeal has been lodged against the said judgment:

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor by section 4 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Wara Wara Hills Forest Reserve) Order, 1960.
2. The land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby constituted a Forest Reserve.

3. The inhabitants of the aforesaid Wara Wara Bafodea and Dembelia Musaia Chiefdoms shall be entitled at all times to enter the Forest Reserve without fee, let or hindrance for the following purposes—

- (a) to travel through the reserve area from place to place; and
- (b) to hunt, capture and kill all wild animals, birds, fish and reptiles in that area providing that fire is not used.

#### THE SCHEDULE

ALL THAT PIECE OF LAND comprising 2,573 acres or thereabouts situated in the Wara Wara Bafodea and Dembelia Musaia Chiefdoms in the Koinadugu District of the Northern Province of Sierra Leone and bounded as follows:—

STARTING from boundary Mark No. 1 which coincides with a concrete beacon inscribed "MUS VIII 3/MUS IX 4" marking the South-east and South-west corners respectively of Fula Cattle Settlement Areas Musaia VIII and Musaia IX and which is 78.30 chains on a bearing of  $189\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  from a similar beacon inscribed "MUS VIII 2/MUS IX 1" situated 2 chains to the South of a point on the motor road from Kabala to Bafodea distant 370.70 chains measured along the road in the direction of Bafodea from the junction of the said road with that leading to the Musaia Stock farm, thence by a series of cut and beacons lines as shown in the following table—

- (4) Boundary Mark No. 2 coincides with a concrete beacon inscribed "MUS VIII 4" marking the South West corner of Fula Cattle Settlement Musaia VIII.

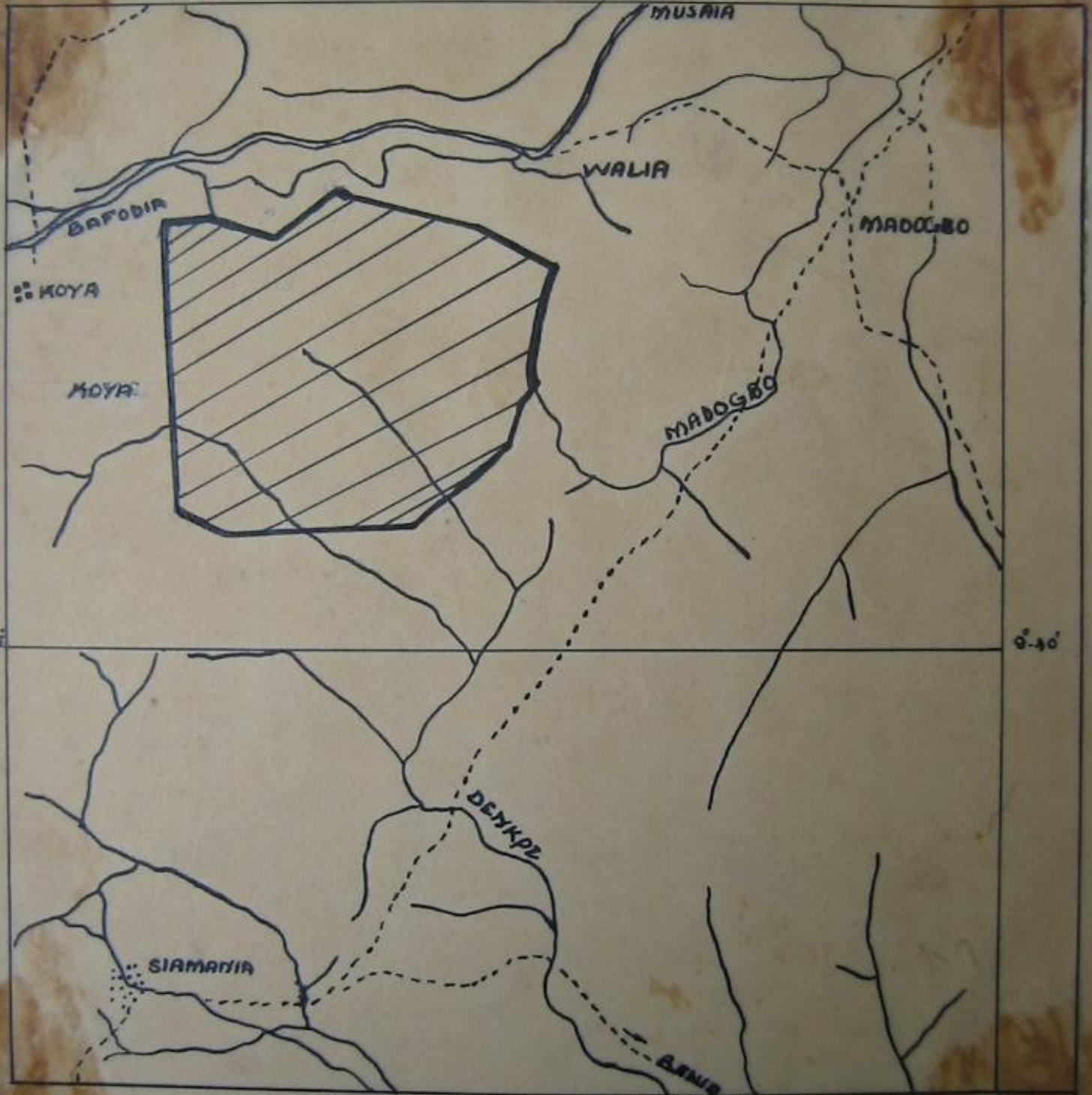
