Match the clause types numbered from (1) to (10) on the left of the table below with the descriptions listed from (a) to (j) on the right of the table.

Clause type	Description of clause
(1) Best endeavours	(a) This clause governs the way in which the parties are to communicate with each other concerning important issues provided for under the contract
(2) Retention of title	(b) This clause governs the making of changes in the performance of the contract
(3) Definition	(c) This clause governs transfer of the contract to another party
(4) Waiver	(d) This clause governs the point at which ownership of and risk in the goods passes from buyer to seller
(5) Whole agreement	(e) This clause specifies that strong efforts should be made to achieve a certain outcome but there is no absolute obligation to achieve it
(6) Exemption	(f) This clause specifies how a certain term is to be interpreted in the contract
(7) Indemnity	(g) This clause specifies that the terms of the contract are those actually contained in the contract
(8) Notices	(h) This clause governs the making of changes to the contract
(9) Assignment	(i) This clause governs circumstances in which one party agrees to protect another party from liability
(10) Amendment	(j) This clause governs circumstances in which contractual liability does not apply
