## Glossary

[disease] elimination: the removal of a disease from a specific region

[disease] eradication: the complete, worldwide removal of a disease from human or animal populations

**herd immunity:** a situation in which a large enough proportion of a population is resistant to a particular disease that the likelihood of a susceptible individual coming in contact with an infected individual becomes so low that disease transmission effectively ceases

"neglected tropical diseases": a group of diseases that are neglected in terms of research or policy attention as a consequence of the lack of political and economic power of the people affected

**orphan disease:** diseases that have been ignored as targets for research because they afflict few people or are concentrated in poor populations and are thus unlikely to return much profit on investment

**quarantine:** the isolation of infectious individuals (or people suspected of being infectious) from uninfected individuals

**ring vaccination:** a vaccination approach in which all the contacts of an infected individual are vaccinated to stem the transmission of the disease
