## **Notice Regarding Minors**

Please note that if you are employing minors (those under 18 years of age) you are required by state law to make sure that they have obtained minor work permits. Films produced under the SAG-AFTRA Low-Budget Agreements must be filmed entirely within the United States and its territories.

**PLEASE RETURN** by fax to the appropriate number listed below at least 3 weeks before the start of principal photography or before producer intends to travel performers (whichever is earlier). A Business Representative will contact you as soon as practicable (normally no later than one week) to follow-up on your request, explain the process and forward the appropriate paperwork.
