Portrait Orientations



- A **frontal view** is an artistic rendering of a person's full-face.



- A **profile** presents a person's head directly from the side. Only one half of the face is visible.



- A **three-quarter view** portrays a head from an angle showing the eyes, nose, and mouth, but not the full face. It is halfway between a frontal view and profile.
