

HOW TO MAKE:

Materials.

Glue Stick

Mod Podge

Paint Brush

Recycled paper scraps

EXTRA: Buttons, Fabrics,

Metal Scraps, & other 3D elements.

Scissors

1. Gather all necessary materials.
This includes recycled or found scraps of paper, metal, fabrics, and other 2D and 3D components.

2. DO NOT start with a plan.
Begin by cutting out pieces of paper and arranging them in various ways. Glue will not be needed at this stage

3. Try arranging your DRY pieces in
explorative ways.
Experiment with your composition!

4. When your composition is to your liking,
begin by gluing down your pieces ordering your layers background to foreground.

Continue applying thin layers of glue
until all pieces are well attached.
