Organizing a MIDI File for Sheet Music Prep

- 1. Remove any plug-ins and virtual instruments.
- 2. Change any single note triggers (woodwind flourish, guitar lick, etc.) to actual notes.
- 3. Quantize performances to desired note values for sheet music. Include note durations, as well.
- 4. Break sectional parts down into individual parts.
- 5. (Optional) Combine tracks with different articulations of the same instrument into a single track.
- Order and name MIDI tracks to conform with traditional score layout.
- 7. Double check everything.
- 8. Save as music prep MIDI file.
