## FABRIC AND COLORED LIGHTING

When considering color choices, the costumer should have a good understanding of the other colors used onstage and how they might affect his/her resulting costume colors. This can be a difficult process, considering stage lighting often uses multiple different types of colored lighting in conjunction with one another during the course of the dance. The chart below includes the colors of fabric and their likely appearance under colored lighting.

I use the term likely because there are always a number of factors, such as the pigment of the dye, the sheen of the fabric, the type of lighting instrument, and more. When in doubt, try to provide a fabric swatch to the lighting designer to see if you can experiment with its appearance under stage lighting.
