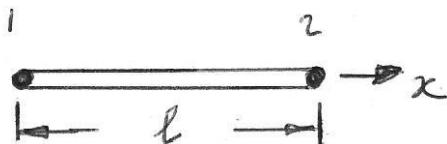


CHAPTER 19 THE FINITE ELEMENT METHOD

EXERCISE 68, Page 407

1. Using the finite element method, determine the elemental stiffness matrix for a uniform section rod, of length l and with end nodes.



2 node rod element:

$$u = \alpha_1 + \alpha_2 x$$

$$\text{At } x = 0, \quad u = u_1$$

$$\text{i.e.} \quad u_1 = \alpha_1$$

$$\text{At } x = l, \quad u = u_2$$

$$\text{i.e.} \quad u_2 = \alpha_1 + \alpha_2 l$$

$$\text{or} \quad \alpha_2 l = u_2 - \alpha_1 = u_2 - u_1$$

$$\text{and} \quad \alpha_2 = \frac{u_2 - u_1}{l}$$

$$\text{Therefore,} \quad u = u_1 + (u_2 - u_1) \frac{x}{l}$$

$$\text{Let} \quad \xi = \frac{x}{l}$$

$$\text{then} \quad u = u_1 + (u_2 - u_1) \xi$$

$$= u_1 (1 - \xi) + u_2 \xi$$

$$\text{or} \quad u = ((1 - \xi) \quad \xi) \begin{pmatrix} u_1 \\ u_2 \end{pmatrix} = (N)(u_i) \quad (1)$$

or $(N) = \begin{pmatrix} (1-\xi) & \xi \end{pmatrix}$ (2)

$$(B) = \frac{d(N)}{dx}$$

or $(B) = \frac{d(N)}{l d\xi} = \begin{pmatrix} -\frac{1}{l} & \frac{1}{l} \end{pmatrix} = \frac{d(N)}{dx}$

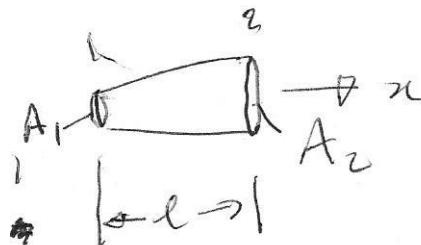
$$(D) = (E)$$

$$(k) = \int (B)^T (D) (B) dx \times A$$

$$= \int_0^1 \frac{AE}{l^2} \begin{pmatrix} -1 \\ 1 \end{pmatrix} (-1 \quad 1) l d\xi$$

i.e. $(k) = \frac{AE}{l} \begin{pmatrix} 1 & -1 \\ -1 & 1 \end{pmatrix}$

2. Determine the stiffness matrix for a rod element whose cross-sectional area varies uniformly from A_1 , at node 1 to A_2 at node 2.



From Problem 1,

$$(N) = \begin{pmatrix} (1-\xi) & \xi \end{pmatrix}$$

Similarly, the cross-sectional area at ξ ,

$$(A) = \begin{pmatrix} A_1(1-\xi) & A_2 \end{pmatrix}$$

$$(B) = \frac{d(N)}{dx}$$

or $(B) = \frac{d(N)}{l d\xi} = \frac{1}{l} (-1 \quad 1)$

$$(D) = (E)$$

$$\begin{aligned}
(k) &= \int (B)^T (D)(B) Al d\xi \\
&= \int \frac{E}{l} (-1 \quad 1) \frac{1}{l} \begin{pmatrix} -1 \\ 1 \end{pmatrix} (A_1(1-\xi) \quad A_2) l d\xi \\
&= \frac{E}{l} \begin{pmatrix} 1 & -1 \\ -1 & 1 \end{pmatrix} \int_0^1 (A_1(1-\xi) \quad A_2) d\xi \\
&= \frac{E}{l} \begin{pmatrix} 1 & -1 \\ -1 & 1 \end{pmatrix} \left(A_1 \left(\xi - \frac{\xi^2}{2} \right) \quad A_2 \frac{\xi^2}{2} \right)_0^1 \\
&= \frac{E}{l} \begin{pmatrix} 1 & -1 \\ -1 & 1 \end{pmatrix} \left(\frac{A_1}{2} \quad \frac{A_2}{2} \right)
\end{aligned}$$

i.e.

$$(k) = \frac{(A_1 + A_2)E}{2l} \begin{pmatrix} \mathbf{1} & -\mathbf{1} \\ -\mathbf{1} & \mathbf{1} \end{pmatrix}$$
