- 1. Identify all expressions functioning as VP adverbials or S-adverbials.
- **2.** Identify all expressions functioning as
 - (a) Direct objects (dO)
 - (b) Indirect objects (iO)
 - (c) Subject predicatives (sP)
 - (d) Object predicatives (oP).
- 3. Using triangles for NPs and APs, draw phrase markers for the underlined expressions.

Before doing this, you might find it useful to revise a point about PPs made in Chapter 3 (pages 54–5).
